I'm a member of your hone Scrunity with Bournville Village Trust. In the group I have taken part in different aspects of services related to social housing & a housing association .

As part of the membership I had to honour to be nominated represent Bournville Village Trust to attend the national Scrunity vonferences when I have took part on different aspects to enable greater voices for tennanta of social housing. The event took place at. Loughborough university and was organised by the organisation Tpas (National Tenancy Advisory Service)

Safety travel participation

A special study was developed jointly by West Midlands Safety Travel Partnership (A partnership led by Transport for West Midlands) and National Neurodiversity Training. This includes a variety of developments including taking part in a video campaign for National Neurodiversity Training to highlight safety matters on Public transport. I appeared on an educational video with detailed aspects on public transport safety. This was distributed to public transport staff and travel safety officers across the public transport system across the west Midlands including the police forces, Transport for West Midlands and the operators.

Redditch Community Forum

Until mid 2023, I took part in a community meeting organisers by Redditch Borough & Bromsgrove District Councils to enable represented voices across all sections of communities.

I am part of the user experience group to improve the customer experience and to improve how information is presented.

I took part in a transport accessibility summit and took part in many participation tasks including user experience on local railway and the proposed franchising of the local bus network in the West Midlands

For the help of West Midlands Safer Travel Partnership, I have two parts in a research on how to improve passenger information with the products team to find ways to enable greater confidence on integrated Transport journeys. This involves a face-to-face meeting and to provide a publication on my analysis, suggestions and solutions related to passenger information and signage. This combines my creative design background and lived experiences as a neurodivergent passenger.

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Music related projects & events

King of the Beats

This music related project is developed & directed by my friend Pritt Kalsi (film maker, music producer) which involves legendary and up & coming music producers & artists

Music challenge

A family of videos documentaries & competition events which challenge producers to develop original true hip-hop with a sound inspired from the 20th Century which incorporates samples of music purchased at record shops with a limited budget.

Since 2018 my involvement includes filming on location at record stores.

The contenders and participants taken part on the earlier video projects includes The Creators, The Nextmen, The P Brothers, Beyond Three, Key Figures, The Unsung heroes, Sparkii Ski, DJ Mr Thing, P Body (from Australia), Si Spex, Joe Maximus, DJ Priority (USA), Devastate (formally a member of the Demon Boyz), DJ Pogo.

Originally this project was a challenge only on video and it has developed into a series of DVD premieres, record releases, live challenges, live tours and DJ Club nights. Also I have participated with a combination of filming and behind the scenes assistance at film screenings (Birmingham & Leicester) & competition events (London & Birmingham)

The album cover is for The "Dia Peace" from Diamond D. This is his first major album from this Bronx (New York) based artist in over a decade. As part of promoting the album, a worldwide competition for design the artwork for the album cover design. The entry featuring me was designed and created by the director of the music & filming project King of the beats Pritt Kalsi sent an entry with a photoshoot featuring me in an environment with an urban New York Bronx feel.

This entry was the winner and it now featured an on album cover distributed worldwide as an LP cover, CD and the artwork for downloads including iTunes and onto MP3 music files.
