Purpose

This Code of Conduct outlines the expected standards of behaviour for all parents and spectators involved with Townsville Basketball Incorporated (TBI) It aims to create a safe, positive, and inclusive environment consistent with TBI's Child Safe and Member Protection Policies.

Expectations of Behaviour

- Encourage fair play and positive sportsmanship from all participants.
- Respect the decisions of referees and officials.
- Never use abusive or threatening language toward players, coaches, or officials.
- Support children in a positive manner, avoiding pressure or criticism.
- Follow venue and association guidelines for behaviour and communication.

Breaches of the Code

Breaches of this Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action, which may include suspension, termination of engagement, or referral to external authorities such as Basketball Queensland or the Queensland Police Service, depending on the severity of the breach.

Reporting

All concerns or breaches should be reported to the General Manager or Child Safety Officer as soon as possible. Reports will be handled in accordance with the TBI Complaints, Reporting and Responding Procedure.
