Alderman Adkins suggested staff compile a list of fees for other peer entities in the region for comparison purposes. Mr. Streiler indicated that he would gather the requested info and prepare a report for the next meeting.

Alderman Adkins shared that he has sat in all the past public hearings as an Alderman, and as a neighbor. He takes issue with speakers that yell at the Board. He wants to do what is morally right and stated that we (the Board) have nothing to gain. He challenged the attendees to look at how the City is run, where the revenue comes from, where Forstell is headed. He noted that the City is working on a Plan (Comprehensive Plan), led by a professional planner. We are all neighbors.
