1. **Call to Order:** Alderman Palmer called the meeting to order at 7:09 pm.

He continued that Jasmine Boyer should be made mayor and closed with "lets do the data center moratorium".

He acknowledged that he's glad the City is working with a contractor to inspect Liberty and hopes the sunken concrete in front of his house is repaired. He also noted that McBride is in violation with the building code that requires sump pumps to include valves.
