WEST MEYER ROAD TO CLOSE TO THROUGH TRAFFIC SEPTEMBER 30

ST. CHARLES COUNTY, MO – The St. Charles County Highway Department will close West Meyer Road from Route W to Duenke Road, Wednesday, September 30, 2026.

The closure is needed for construction work on West Meyer Road. The closure will last for about one month before this section re-opens. More closure sections will be announced in the future, following this project.



Traffic will be required to follow the detour signs around the closure. Drivers on West Meyer Road can detour north on Route W to Duenke Road, then go south on Duenke Road to reconnect with West Meyer. Local residents will be allowed limited access on West Meyer Road to get to their homes.

Access to Oglesby Park will be from the Duenke Road side of the closure.

This road improvement project is part of a continuing effort by St. Charles County Government to improve the County's road system for the safety of the travelling public.
