Built on the pillars of **Health & Wellness**, **Sustainable Agriculture**, and **Global Technology**, RMCS offers STEAM-based, student-centered programming designed to equip students with real-world skills and lifelong learning habits. The school is preparing to open in **September 2025**, pending finalization of a school facility.

Position Summary

The Principal will serve as the instructional and operational leader of the school, responsible for building a strong school culture, leading teaching and learning, and supporting student achievement. Working closely with the Superintendent and Board, the Principal will help lay the foundation for an innovative and inclusive educational environment aligned with Alberta's **Leadership Quality Standard (LQS)** and the school's charter.

Key Responsibilities

- Provide instructional leadership that fosters academic excellence and student well-being.
- Support curriculum development, classroom planning, and locally developed courses aligned with the school's pillars.
- Hire, support, and evaluate teachers and staff in accordance with Alberta Education standards.
- Develop school-wide policies, timetables, and operational procedures.
- Promote a positive, inclusive, and collaborative school culture that supports all learners.
- Support students' social, emotional, and academic development, and ensure effective intervention practices.
- Build and maintain strong relationships with families, staff, Alberta Education, and the broader community.
- Ensure compliance with the Education Act, charter regulations, and provincial reporting requirements.
