Welcome to Women Build!

Thank you for joining Women Build! As a participant, you'll help raise money for supplies to build the house, and you'll also contribute your time on-site, working alongside other volunteers and a professional supervisor. We need both the funds and the volunteer construction support to make a family's dream of homeownership come true!

1. Set Up Your Personal Fundraising Page

This is how you'll officially register as a Women Build volunteer.

- **Log into GoFundMe Pro** using this link: [Women Build 2026](#)
- **Click "Become a Fundraiser"** then "Join a team" and follow the prompts to create your individual fundraising page.
- **Set a personal fundraising goal.** The suggested goal is \$225 to help your team reach its overall goal. You can edit this goal to one that is comfortable for you.
- **Reach out for donations.** Family members, friends, neighbors, co-workers, and members of your faith community are all great people to ask. Every donation counts! Even donations of \$5 can add up quickly.
- **Ask your employer** if they have a matching gift program or would consider sponsoring your team.
- Donations can be made directly on your fundraising page, so be sure to share the link with your supporters.
- Alternatively, checks can be made payable to **Greater Rochester Habitat for Humanity** with "WB, [your team name], [your name]" noted in the memo line.

2. Visit the Women Build Volunteer Calendar

Check the Women Build volunteer calendar regularly to stay updated on available build days. New build days are posted frequently and updated every few weeks. You can access the calendar here: [Women Build Volunteer Calendar](#). Your team leader will share the join code to access your team's reserved build day(s). Keep an eye out for "All Women Welcome" days, when Women Build volunteers from any team can join.

3. Receive Build Day Information

A few days before your scheduled build day, you'll receive an email with specific details about the work that will be done and what you should bring with you to the site.

4. Stay Informed

Regularly visit the Women Build webpage to stay up to date on news, updates, and progress toward our fundraising goals.

5. Take Pictures at Your Build Day

Capture some great moments while on-site! Sharing photos of your workday is a great way to show your supporters how their donations are making a real difference. They'll love hearing from you and seeing the progress you've made together!

6. Spread the Word!

After your build day, share your experience with others! Your story can inspire others to get involved or donate.
