

NONPROFITS IMPACT LINCOLN!

Cause Collective annually surveys Lincoln nonprofits. We share this information to help build awareness of the economic and social impact nonprofits provide to Lincoln and the State of Nebraska.
This data includes the results of the 2024 survey (105 nonprofits in Lancaster County responding).

Economic Impact:

1,904 people employed at nonprofits

Social Impact:

3,404 individuals served (unduplicated)

(The **average** number of **people served** in Lincoln **each year, per agency.**)

3,085,672 encounters at nonprofits

(An “encounter” is when a nonprofit provides a service to an individual--may be in person or remote.)
