

COUNT YOUR BLESSINGS

The Daily Bread November 26

When I was a little girl, I loved the old hymn "Count Your Blessings." The song encourages those who are "tempest-tossed" and "thinking all is lost" to "count your blessing, name them one by one." Years later when my husband, Alan, was discouraged, he would often ask me to sing that simple song to him. Then I would help him to enumerate his blessings. Doing this took Alan's focus off his struggles and self-doubt and centered his thoughts on God and his reasons for thankfulness.

The book of Ezra describes God's people overwhelming challenges through focusing on God's power and provisions. After they'd endured decades of captivity in Baylon, King Cyrus allowed the Jewish exiles to return to Israel to rebuild the temple (Ezra 1-2). Only a fraction returned (2:64). Despite their "fear of the peoples around them" and the great task before them, they rebuilt the alter and laid the temple's foundation (3:3,10). Then "with praise and thanksgiving they sang to the Lord: 'He is good; His love toward Israel endures forever. 'And all the people gave a great shout of praise to the Lord" (3:11).

If you're discouraged or facing seemingly insurmountable obstacles, turn you thought toward God. "Count your blessings" and it will surprise you what the Lord has done, and continues to do, for those who love him.


The Worship Committee will be decorating the church for the Christmas season the week of Nov 24th. Anyone who wants to be a part of this project should contact LeNell.

These three tools will help you take every thought captive and test the messages that replay in your mind against the truth of God's Word. You will also learn


to overcome common thought traps like anxiety, guilt, rejection, dissatisfaction, and more. No matter who you are or where you come from, progress is possible.

News from the Food Pantry

In the month of October we were able to serve 498 families representing a total of 1124 individuals.

Thanksgiving is Thursday, November 27. At the pantry, this means that we will be giving out Thanksgiving meals on Tuesday and Wednesday, November 25 and 26. We usually give out close to 300 meals.

You can help with distribution by volunteering to help at the pantry on those days or by donating Thanksgiving meals or items for a meal. Check with Ricky to see what items he needs most. Below is the list of items included in a meal.

Turkey (frozen) 10-+15 lbs.

Green Beans - two cans

Stuffing Mix -one 14-16 oz, bag or box

Instant mashed Potatoes-one box 14 oz. or larger



Mission Opportunity

Dear Friends and Members of the Community,

We are reaching out to you with a heartfelt plea to assist a family in dire need. The Woods family is currently living without hot water or heat in their home, a situation that is not only uncomfortable but also unsafe as winter approaches. Our church, Elmwood West Methodist Church, is launching a fundraising campaign to cover the plumbing costs necessary to restore heat and hot water to their home.

Background:

The gas piping in the Woods' home is in poor condition, and the gas company cannot turn on the gas until this issue is resolved. To ensure the family can safely heat their home and access hot water, we need to run new gas pipes into the house. After careful consideration and two estimates, we have chosen Chris Brown from C Brown Plumbing LLC, who has generously offered to complete the work for \$5,800—\$2,000 less than any other estimate. He is also willing to work with us on payment options.

How You Can Help:

We are inviting individuals and other churches to contribute to this essential cause. Our congregation, while deeply compassionate, is small and struggling financially, making it challenging for us to cover the entire cost. We would like to offer a "registry" style option, where you can select a portion of the plumbing work you would like to sponsor. - This includes the installation of new gas lines and necessary materials, labor, and city permit fees.
