

Toslink optical to audio connection

A Toslink connector, which is more commonly referred to as an optical Audio connector, or digital audio out, sends the audio data along a fibre optic or similar cable.

To convert this data to the more familiar RCA composite sockets, (red and white for audio, yellow for video), we connect a Toslink converter.

1. Toslink plug. Connects from the Toslink box into the Toslink socket on the television.



2. Toslink socket. Found on the rear of the television.



3. Toslink box. The Toslink box requires a 5V power supply (power transformer supplied). The red and white RCA sockets are used to connect to the sound source (headset etc).
