...speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the LORD. Eph. 5:18-19

Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate... II Cor. 6:17

As a newborn babe in Christ, I was given a King James Scofield Study Bible, a Living Bible, a Good News for Modern Man, and finally a Compact King James Bible. I'm sure the givers meant well, but no one said anything about Bible translations. However, I did begin memorizing Scripture daily from the King James Bible. From somewhere, I obtained a number of study booklets that were the New American Standard version. Several years further into my walk with Jesus, the "textual" issue and modern Bible versions became a serious study for me. There are actually only two types of Bibles. Those that have come from the "Received Text" family of manuscripts and those that come from the "Critical Text" family. The Received Text has historically been used by churches dating back to the time of the apostles. Whereas, the Critical Text has only dominated new translations for the last 150 years. {For more, request the book *Not One Jot Or Tittle*, Dr. Putney}

If we do not get it right on the Scripture, GOD'S HOLY BIBLE, we will not get it right. In Spirit and in Truth we must worship; our Song must be holy and true. Come out, dear child of GOD, and be Separate for HIS GLORY. Amen

Contending for Fundamental Christianity *Scripture*

The Doctrine of Scriptural Preservation

This simple three-point outline will guide your study.

1. Source – Think about this question. Does the pure, preserved Word of God originate in corrupt sources? Modern Bible versions are from corrupt “Critical” manuscripts previously obscure and discarded. Men have taken upon themselves the authority to fix these sources and declare them the Word of God. These scholars that are now the authority on the Word of God have not even believed in the inspired, infallible Word of God.

2. Scholars – Again, think about this question. Are these scholars, who believe there are errors in the Bible that they must fix, men of God? These men/scholars who believe in evolution, German rationalism, spiritism and other false teachings are the men responsible for this critical text source of modern Bible versions.

3. Scripture – We will talk about God’s Scripture in a moment, but corrupt scripture is the result of private interpretation. Adding to, taking away from, and changing the meaning of vital teaching is part of this critical text scholarship. Again, did God use obscure, corrupted text, and a manmade scientific method directed by men with beliefs contrary to the very Book they claim to be correcting with the “higher criticism”?

Satan did not try to persuade Adam and Eve that there was no God. Satan rather attacked God’s Word and God’s character. Do you remember what the serpent said as he attacked God’s Word? Here it is, “Yea, hath God said?” This grotesque vile attack was Satan’s implantation of corruption and doubt into the woman’s heart. Thus, from the beginning came the attack on God’s Word.

Over 3,000 times God’s pure, preserved Word records the Scriptures’ divinely inspired origin. *In the beginning God...In the beginning was the Word!* II Peter 1:19-21 says,

We have also a more sure Word of prophecy; whereunto ye do well that ye take heed, as unto a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day star arise in your hearts; knowing this first, that no prophecy of the scripture is of any private interpretation. For the prophecy came not in old time by the will of man; but holy men of God spake as they were moved by the Holy Ghost.

We have God’s Word on this subject!

Song

The Doctrine of Biblical Music

O come, let us sing unto the LORD: let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation. Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and make a joyful noise unto him with psalms.

Psalm 95:1 & 2

O sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth.

Psalm 96:1

The music, melody, harmony and sounds of the believer is a new song not the sounds, beat, base and boom of the world. God's music is not entertainment and emotion. Surely our LORD ministers to our hearts and HIS music moves us deeply and emotionally. HIS music is powerful. *Praise ye the LORD: for it is good to sing praises unto our God.* Our praises and song should be reverent, majestic melodies that glorify and honour our LORD. Our music should be full of sound doctrine and Scripture. In the church, our music should lead us to HIM in worship, praise and edification of the saints. Colossians 3:16 says, "Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts." The ministry of music in our hearts is to teach and admonish us to a more holy, separated walk in Christ. These psalms and hymns and spiritual songs are sung with grace in our hearts to the LORD. This is not a performance but a purifying of the child of God.

We have been called out of this world. Out of the world's fashion, fads, and fluff. Our testimonies in song should demonstrate this changed life. The world's sensual and self-gratification has no place or part in the saint's song. The Holy Spirit promises to guide us in all truth. An unsaved person will know what the world's music sounds like. Yet, in a believer, the indwelling Holy Spirit will make clear the difference in the world's music and Godly psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. No doubt, the child of God must refuse the Holy Spirit's leading into scriptural worship and song in order to embrace the worldly, carnal music that has crept into the church today. HE shall direct thy paths; NOT the pop, rock and top ten charts.

The Doctrine of Biblical Holiness

In 1970, the craze was *Three Dog Night*, *Blood, Sweat, and Tears*, *Chicago*, *Cream*, and more addictions of rock'n roll. Yet the transforming power of the Holy Spirit gave my heart new manna from heaven in the form of "Power in the Blood," "To God be the Glory," and "How Great Thou Art." Hallelujah, what a Saviour, Jesus is mine! So as a Christian, why do we do what we do? As a Christian, why do we sing the songs we sing? As a Christian why do we go where we go, and wear what we wear? I Corinthians 10:31 says, "Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God." Certainly, that should be our motivation. Mini-skirts, bikinis, pants on women, along with shape-revealing, flesh-exposing designs were key components to the clothing revolution from the 1920s to the 1960s. Fast-forward to the 2000s in churches across America, and that display seems mild compared to body piercings, tattoos, and the accoutrements of many modern day choirs and worship leaders. Sadly, is the church trying to surpass the world in carnality? The Holy Spirit has already spoken. HE indwells the born again child of God. The Holy Spirit of God teaches and convicts the child of God. Then we *prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God*.

Be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. Romans 12:2

But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should show forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvelous light. I Peter 2:9

Now talk about praising and singing praises unto God, think about that Scripture! We are to show forth the praises of Him who hath done *what*? He hath called us *out of darkness*, out of this world of sin, *into His marvelous light*. Dr. M.R. DeHaan said, "As followers of the Lord Jesus Christ, we must be willing to leave the camp of the world, and the unbelievers, and even false religious professors, and be willing to walk alone with Christ in the path of **separation**."

Be ye not unequally yoked together with unbelievers: for what fellowship hath righteousness with unrighteousness? and what communion hath light with darkness?.... II Corinthians 6:14-18.
