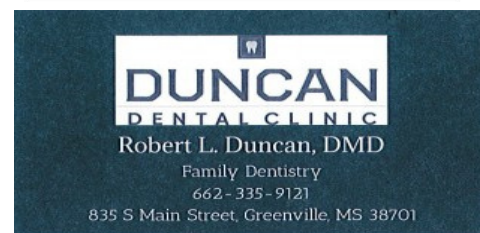

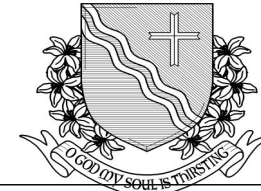

Steubenville Youth Conference 2026

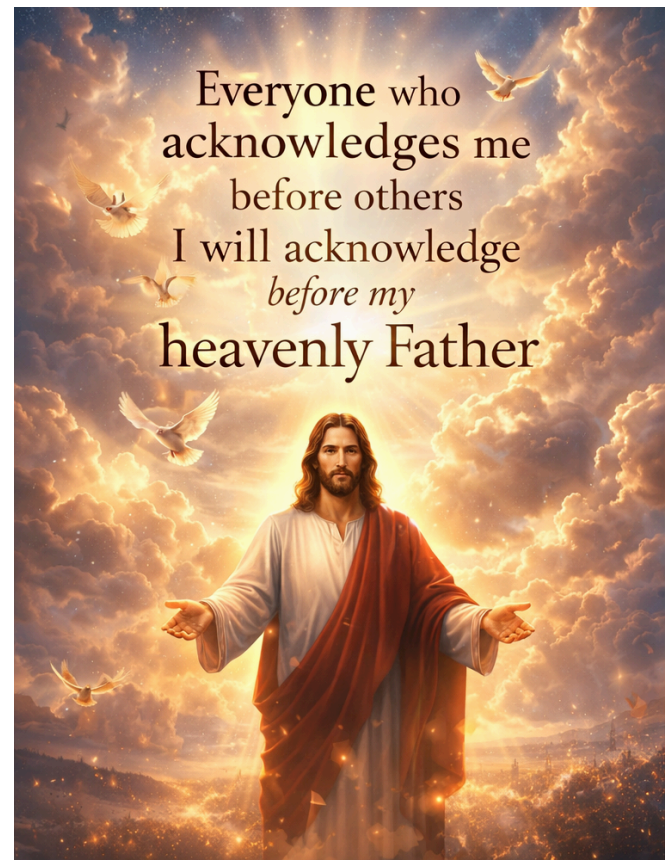
