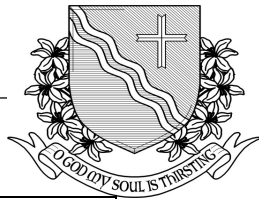

FRAUD PREVENTION HOTLINE

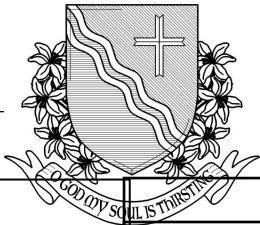


Death
