This General Price List reflects our commitment to providing consumer information to each family that we are privileged to serve. While itemizing specific costs, we have also established Professional Service Options which reflect traditional types of services most frequently requested. As questions may arise, please do not hesitate to request additional information. We welcome the opportunity to address your concerns and appreciate the confidence you have placed in us. We are committed to your trust and satisfaction.

Unlike some service industries, we provide our families with the security of flat-rate pricing. Whereas, some professionals require a retainer and charge at an hourly rate with no real assurance of how many hours they might need to complete their job. It is our commitment to you that the preparation of the death certificate, obtaining the physician's signature, securing the required disposition permit from the county, along with the time we will spend meeting with you today and that which may be required to meet your family's needs, are included in this price structure. Additionally, as you review our General Price List, you will see that you will not be charged for anything that you do not request.

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

TRANSFER OF REMAINS TO FUNERAL HOME (within Yolo County)-(up to 300 lbs.).....\$495.00

EMBALMING PREPARATION..... \$595 (up to 300 lbs.) If over 300 lbs. **add** \$570.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial. Some cemeteries require embalming when placing remains in a mausoleum crypt. Embalming is the disinfection and temporary chemical preservation of the body. Embalming service at Smith Funeral Home is provided by a professional licensee of the State of California.

Requirements for embalming and restoration are situational and determined at the discretion of the funeral director to protect the health and emotional well-being of the general public and our client families.

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF\$2,045.00

Our professional services include, but are not limited to, consultation with family and clergy, arrangements and direction of services, preparation and filing of required documentation and authorizations; services, prior, during and following funeral including coordination with those providing other portions of funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory, office staff and accounting, 24-hour availability to transport decedent into our care. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance and utility expenses and administrative costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charges for service packages, direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding or receiving remains.

PAYMENT OPTIONS

Smith Funeral Home has established a uniform payment policy to serve all families fairly. This policy requires that all financial arrangements be completed two full days before merchandise is ordered/services are provided. The following are acceptable payment options:

1. Pre-arranged funeral plan through Smith Funeral Home.
2. Cash, personal check, cashier's check or money order. A service fee of \$25.00 will be added for bounced check.
3. VISA, MasterCard, Discover, American Express accepted with a **3.5% convenience fee of total contract added.**
4. Insurance Assignment (Fee of \$1,695.00) requires verification, surrender of the policy and assignability. A contract with the beneficiary and next of kin for financial responsibility must be signed in the event that claim is not valid or honored. **All insurance assignments require payment in full of cash advance, merchandise and assignment fee at the time of need.**
