SERVICE, FACILITIES, AND EQUIPMENT

The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Basic Services of Funeral Director and Staff \$3495

This is a basic fee we charge every family we serve regardless of their funeral preferences. It includes obtaining necessary authorizations and consents, consultation with the family, administrative and clerical services, and a fee necessary to cover a proportionate share of our overhead costs, such as taxes, licenses, insurance, maintenance of facilities and equipment, utilities, compliance with federal, state, and local regulations, and a variety of other costs related to being in business to serve the public. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. This fee is already included in our charge for direct cremations, immediate burials, and forwarding and receiving remains.

Transfer of Remains to Funeral Home* \$ 575

◇ Transfer fee for removal requiring two attendants \$ 280

*Local Service Area

Embalming \$ 745

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain arrangements, such as funeral with a viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

OTHER ARRANGEMENTS

Chapel and Facilities for Memorial Service* \$ 1500

This is a basic fee that we charge every family previously served by another funeral service provider. This option includes a proportionate share of the taxes, licenses, maintenance, insurance, and other business expenses required to serve the public on a twenty-four hour basis. Our charge includes, but is not limited to: consultation with the family, administrative and clerical services, writing and submitting the obituary to selected newspapers. It also includes supervision of the memorial ceremony, consultation with the church and clergy, clubs and organizations, care and handling of floral tributes and cards, delivery of floral tributes to a local cemetery, and preparation of the obituary record for the clergy. Weekend fee in addition.

Disinterment Services* \$ 3095

This service option includes the following:

- ◇ Limited service of funeral director and staff
- ◇ Documentation fee
- ◇ Heavy duty transport bag
- ◇ Airtray

This service option does not include the following:

- ◇ Replacement casket, if necessary
- ◇ Transportation fees, if necessary

Anatomical Donation* \$ 2115

This service option includes the following:

- ◇ Limited service of funeral director and staff
- ◇ Local removal
- ◇ Temporary storage
- ◇ Coordination with the curator

This service option does not include the following:

- ◇ Transportation fees to the place of donation

MINIMUM ARRANGEMENTS

Forwarding Remains to Another Funeral Home \$ 3295

Our charge for forwarding remains to another funeral, without formal viewing, visitation, or ceremony includes the limited services of funeral director and staff, local removal, embalming, consultation with receiving funeral home, and transfer to San Francisco International Airport.

Additional charges apply for the following:

- ◇ Casket or shipping container
- ◇ Air tray (required by the airlines)
- ◇ Air fare

Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home \$ 2495

Our charge for receiving remains from another funeral home includes transfer from San Francisco International Airport, the limited services of funeral director and staff, and delivery to a local cemetery.

This does not include the following: viewing, funeral ceremony, merchandise, additional transportation, or any other item from the General Price List.

Immediate Burial \$ 2950 - \$ 32945

These prices include the limited services of funeral director and staff, local removal, dressing of remains, and transportation to a local cemetery.

This does not include the following: embalming/refrigeration, viewing, funeral ceremony, merchandise, taxes, cemetery expense or any other service available from the General Price List.

Price Range:

- ◇ Immediate burial with container provided by purchaser \$ 2950
- ◇ Immediate burial with minimum casket \$ 4045
- ◇ Immediate burial with casket selected from our showroom \$ 2950

This fee added to the price of the casket.



FUNERAL ARRANGEMENTS, CONT'D

Graveside or Cryptside Service Option \$5460

This service option includes the following:

- ◇ Basic service of funeral director and staff
- ◇ Local removal
- ◇ Refrigeration of unembalmed remains (2 days)*
- ◇ Cleansing and handling of unembalmed remains
- ◇ Use of equipment and staff for graveside or cryptside service
- ◇ Local use of hearse, flower vehicle, and first call transfer car

***Some cemeteries require embalming for placement into a crypt. If embalming is required, there will be an additional fee difference of \$495 added to this package.**

Memorial Cremation Arrangement \$ 3495

This service option does not include the following:

- ◇ Viewing
- ◇ Cremation container
- ◇ Durable cremated remains receptacle
- ◇ Cash advances items, state regulatory fee, merchandise, and sales tax
- ◇ Excessive weight fee, if decedent exceeds 300 pounds

Cremation Process (up to 300 pounds) \$ 475

- ◇ (over 300 pounds) \$ 225
- ◇ Witness of the cremation process \$ 220
- ◇ Special request of cremation scheduling \$ 220
- ◇ Expedited cremation within 2 days *(if available)* \$ 295



CREMATION ARRANGEMENTS

Direct Cremation Arrangement \$ 1975 - \$ 11525

This service option includes the following:

- ◇ Limited service of funeral director and staff
- ◇ Local removal
- ◇ Refrigeration for two days
- ◇ Cremation process

This service option does not include the following:

- ◇ Viewing
- ◇ Funeral ceremony
- ◇ Cremation container
- ◇ Durable cremated remains receptacle
- ◇ Cash advances items, state regulatory fee, merchandise, and sales tax
- ◇ Excessive weight fee, if decedent exceeds 300 pounds

If you want to arrange a direct cremation, you can use an alternative container. Alternative containers encase the body and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials (with or without outside covering). The containers we provide are made of cardboard, fiberboard, covered particleboard, or exposed soft or hardwoods.

Price Range:

- ◇ Direct cremation arrangement with container provided by purchaser \$ 1975
- ◇ Direct cremation arrangement with minimum cardboard container \$ 2075
- ◇ Direct cremation arrangement with casket selected from selection room. This fee added to the price of the unit. \$ 1975
