- J7.i. Preference in the draw for Open Stakes
- (2) Spaniels

A First, Second or Third in an Open Stake or a First in a Novice Stake or All Aged (excluding trials restricted to (AV Spaniel except for Spaniel [Cocker] and Spaniel [English Springer]).

To qualify for preference in the draw in an Open Spaniel Stake, the dog must have gained the appropriate places in a Stake open to its breed.

- J7.j. Order of Draws
- (1) Open stakes
- i. Members' first preference dogs which have gained places as shown above.
- ii. Members' second preference dogs which have gained places as shown above.
- iii. Non-members' first preference dogs which have gained places as shown above.
- iv. Non-members' second preference dogs which have gained places as shown above.
- v. Members' dogs which have gained other places.
- vi. Non-members' dogs which have gained other places.
- vii. Other dogs.

The foregoing places must have been gained in a Stake qualifying for entry in the Kennel Club Stud Book.

- (2) Novice Stakes
- i. Members' first preference dogs.
- ii. Members' second preference dogs.
- iii. Non-members' first preference dogs.
- iv. Non-members' second preference dogs.

k. All Aged Stakes may be restricted by any conditions determined by the society (See J3.d(2)). In all cases members' dogs which meet the conditions of entry should take preference in the draw.

Rules and Regulations:

1. Should circumstances so dictate, the Society, in consultation with the Judges, may alter arrangements as necessary such change and the circumstances surrounding them are report to the Kennel Club at the earliest opportunity.

- 2. No modification will be made to this schedule except by permission of the Kennel Club, followed by advertisement in appropriated journals of time permits before close of entries.
- 3. Dogs entered at Kennel club Licensed Field Trial must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulation for Classification and Registration B.
- 4. All dog resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the competitor.
- 5. If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners, the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot.
- 6. The Society accepts no responsibility for damage to or loss of property of person attending the Trials
- 7. The Society reserves the right to refuse entries.
- 8. If the bank dishonours fee or entry fee, then that competitor will be rejected from the Draw or list of Runners.
- 9. All unused cheques will be destroyed after the Trial.
- 10. No substitution of dogs whilst reserves still stand.
- 11. If more than one entry has been applied for, the first on the Entry Form will be assumed to be the choice of priority.
- 12. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership. Entry Fees are subject to Kennel Club 'J' Regulation J7f.
- 13.
- 14. WELFARE OF DOGS. A Competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not knowingly put their dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
- 15. DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS. Your dog is vulnerable and **AT RISK** if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on a day considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damaged caused.
- 16. All mobile phone must be switched off during trial.
- 17. All dogs must be registered at the kennel Club in the name of the owner/applicant prior to the closing date of entries.
- 18. The Start of the Trial will be deemed to be when the Chief Steward announces the Trial has started. If any competitor is absent at the time a reserve dog/competitor will take the vacant place.
- 19. JOINT OWNERSHIP. Joint owners of a dog, who are separate Members of the Society, have ONE preference in the first draw. Both owners must be fully paid up members of the Society.
- 20. First preference in the Draw for all Stakes will be given to those Members fully paid up 30th April. Of each year.
