Nestled on the edge of Skjálfandi Bay, the town of Húsavík is globally recognised as one of the best locations in the world from which to watch whales. In fact, the chances of seeing whales in Húsavík are so high that the town has become known as the whale capital of Iceland. Húsavík and its near surroundings offer a uniquely wide variety of attractions, both natural and cultural.

The northeast of Iceland has a lot to offer, and the most beautiful sights are easily reachable from Húsavík. The Diamond Circle can be described as a magnificent circuit of 250km in the Northeast of Iceland, which includes some of the most stunning sights and spots for unearthly landscapes. Travelling the Arctic Coast Way means leaving the common routes behind you and going off the beaten track to discover some of the most remote places in North Iceland; a unique adventure following 900 km of coastal roads close to the Arctic Circle.

What more to do in and around Húsavík?

Horseback Riding, whether the guests are looking for a one-hour trial lesson along the beach or tours through the highlands lasting several days and accommodation in remote

Birdwatching, with a range of different landscapes and many different terrains within easy reach, Húsavík is an excellent base from which to explore Iceland's ornithology. The entire Northeast of Iceland is notoriously known among bird watchers for its many species and great locations.

Last but not least, baths. The geothermal sea baths enable you to enjoy nature in a unique manner. Thanks to the underground heat, the seawater in the baths is warm and comfortable, and the mineral-rich water will caress your skin. The swimming pool is a great spot for those looking to exercise, meet the locals in the hot tub or have fun on the water slides.

Húsavík also offers three museums, The Húsavík Whale Museum, The Culture House and the newest one, a Eurovision Exhibition dedicated to Iceland's history in the competition. Various restaurants and cafés, local shops and yoga. All around enjoyable experiences.
