Brief Update on Projects in Process

- Window tinting: Entire WDC windows are completed
- <u>Park Internet:</u> Waiting on the state for Starlink to be installed and will be the first for Florida State Parks. We will be in the DEP network. Lovers Key has been without Internet 2 ½ years since Hurricane Ian on September 28, 2022. Requesting there be a press release.
- <u>Summer Camps and Scholarships</u>: one scholarship, planning and registrations going well.
- <u>Donor Board:</u> Katie created the screen images and just need to merge information. Not listed by donor level, just by name in alphabetical order.
- <u>Fans:</u> Tina has a contact through Dan's Fan City to hang fans not purchased through them. We are holding off on ordering the fans until we know when the park will have electricity again, after Hurricanes Helene and Milton. We will be ready at a later date to approve four 84" fans at \$539.95 each for ground level of WDC

- Internet Merchandise sales update: The test of Printify has been initiated. Sales have come in without advertising. Need to post on Facebook and Newsletter. In short, to explain how Printify works (thank you JWN for the simplification) ... If you order something on Amazon, you don't sign a document, or check a box agreeing to their terms & conditions. By using their website, you have agreed to their terms & condition. Printify is no different.

- Gala planning starts in August, but we need to get ahead of it with auction items: Karen has two possible board candidates who may be joining our Gala committee.
- Brainstorming for sponsors of Gala, auction items: With development a hot topic in FMB, we will steer clear of developers for sponsors. Jim saw a Havana hotel in Key West and other ideas were thrown out for auction items to seek.
- Review of April FOLK Financial Statements: We had \$125,000 earmarked for a truck for the rangers and no longer buying that. As such, have it to distribute to more needy projects.
 We need a larger percentage of smaller donors due to state park criteria.

Need more fundraising projects. Kathy Nash reported \$5,070 has been raised so far Adopt-A-Nest. Nine of them are repeat sponsors. Kathy will be on Beach Talk Radio in 2 weeks.

- Park Updates:
 - Mid-Beach Pedestrian Bridge (Katie): Working on constructing the railings and hope to be completed by the end of summer.
 - Park Summary Notes (Katie): The request for electricity after Hurricanes Helene and Milton has been approved by the state.
 - Resource Management Projects upcoming (Katie):
 - Hurricane Season Preparations (WDC Storage Room items) (Katie): There is a state park plan which will have a test run in the near future. Trucks and trailers will come from another park to pick up park equipment in harms way during a hurricane threat. Empty the storage under the WDC and all will be taken off site to higher ground.

Main Entrance Landscaping/ Refresh (Katie, Christy)

Main Restroom Shower Area Landscaping/ Refresh (Katie, Christy) (\$10,000 budgeted for both projects – Duramen proposals \$33,360)

- Motion to approve \$33,600 for the park landscape project: Christy
- Seconded: John
- Discussion: we will wait on the interior ponds after being advised how to proceed and secure grants to fund it. To get the equipment back in there to clean out the hurricane damaged ponds, there was some clearing, exposing the ponds. Taking advantage of the view, trails are being moved over there and benches will eventually be installed. There was \$5,000 donated by the Bonita Woman's Club and Katie will pursue Bonita Bay for a donation.
