

About our PSR program:

- United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) approved curriculum.
- Combination of In-Person and At-Home lessons:
 - ◆ Students meet 2 times per month on Sunday Mornings at St. Patrick's.
 - ◆ Three more lessons, each with online session reviews, are completed at home monthly.
- Scheduled gatherings each month with PSR parents and the Catechetical Leader.
- Intergenerational celebrations for the Liturgical Year.
- PSR Family Service Projects for local & international needs.
- Additional sacrament preparation for Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation.
- Student involvement in monthly Family Mass at 5:00pm the 1st Sunday of each month (October—May).

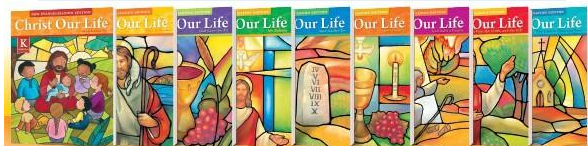


Who may attend?



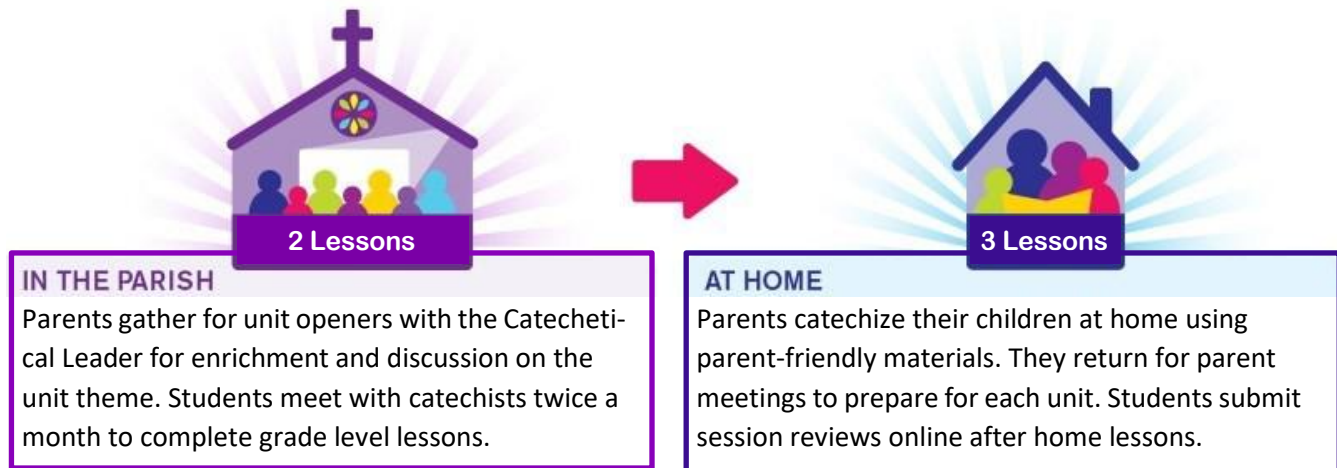
- Registered St. Malachi & St. Patrick Parishioners in PreK-Gr 8

We use the Family Catechesis Model. Here's how it works:



How do we prepare children to receive the sacraments?

- We offer Sacramental Preparation for Reconciliation, Eucharist and Confirmation.
- In order to receive one of these sacraments at St. Patrick or St. Malachi Parishes, a child must be enrolled in PSR or be attending a Catholic school to complete the required groundwork. This should be discussed with the Catechetical Leader prior to registration.
- First Reconciliation and First Eucharist are celebrated at each parish in the spring.
- We can work with your child at any age to receive these sacraments.
- Confirmation is celebrated annually at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist on a prescribed date in combination with other parishes.
- Confirmation preparation will consist of 4 sessions per year for 2 years (typically during 7th & 8th grades) plus either Catholic school or PSR enrollment.
