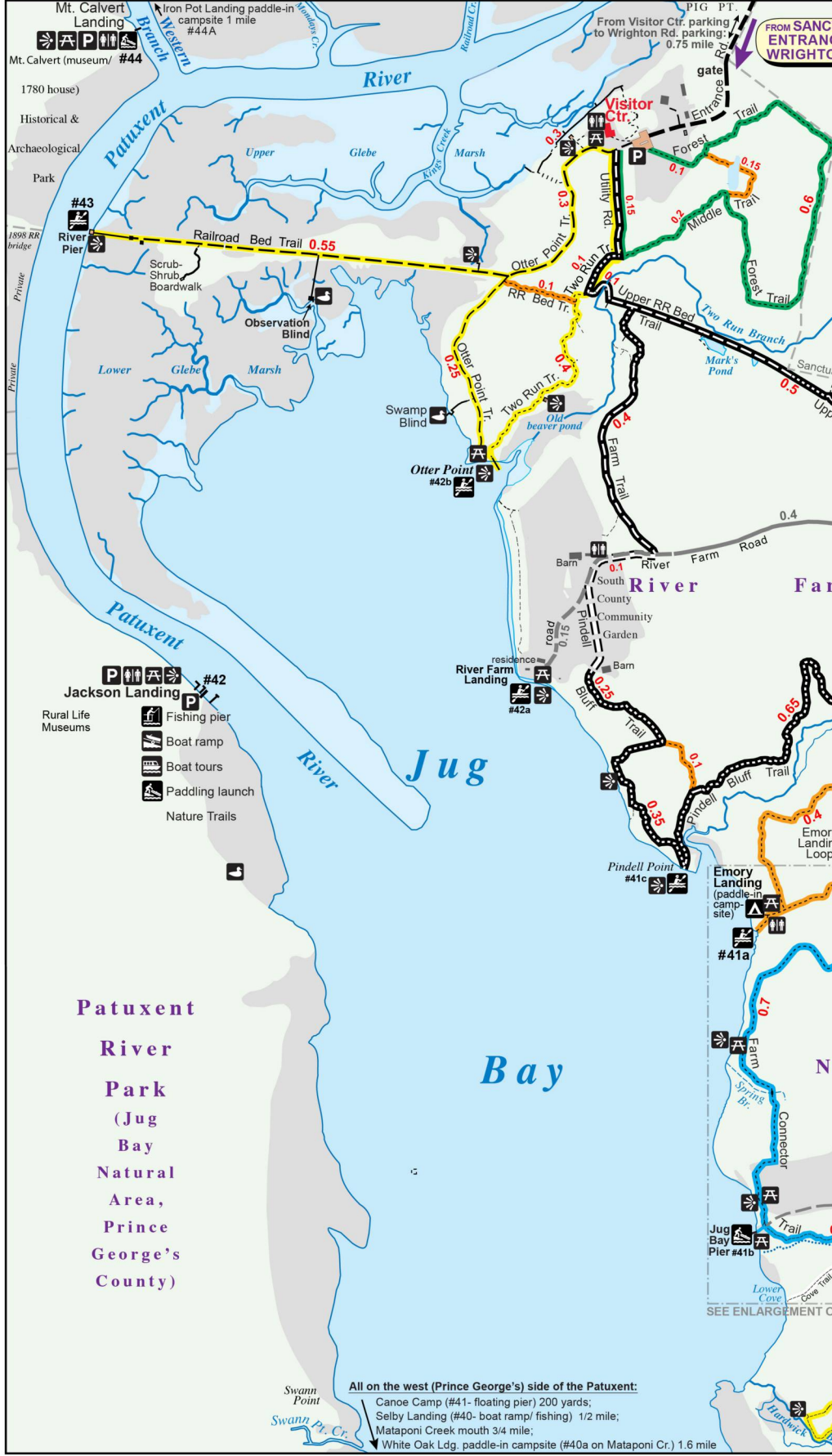




Anne Arundel County, Maryland

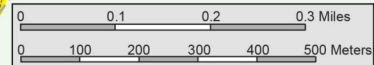
Three loop hikes originating at the Visitor Center:

- 1) Green Loop 1.1 miles 2) Yellow Loop 2.4 miles
3) White Loop 4.1 miles **All distances are in miles.**
Shortest route from the Wetlands Ctr. to **Jug Bay Pier**:
4.4 miles round trip, via the Utility Road, then Two Run Trail,
then Upper Railroad Bed Trail, then Pinzell Bluff Trail, & then the
two mile (round trip) Farm Connector Trail.

BLUE SHIRT NECK

All on the west (Prince George's) side of the Patuxent:

- Canoe Camp (#41- floating pier) 200 yards;
- Selby Landing (#40- boat ramp/ fishing) 1/2 mile;
- Mataponi Creek mouth 3/4 mile;
- White Oak Ldg. paddle-in campsite (#40a on Mataponi Cr.) 1.6 mile
