TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. All games bowled in this tournament are subject to the rules of the United States Bowling Congress. Tournament Management reserves the right to reject or rerate any entrant prior to the entrant's first event.
- 2. ALL BOWLERS MUST PRESENT THEIR USBC CERTIFICATION CARD AT TIME OF CHECK-IN. IF NOT PRESENTED A CARD MUST BE PURCHASED BEFORE BOWLING. Upon proof of a paid card, monies will be refunded.
- 3. All USBC members 45 years of age or older at the time of bowling their first event, who are members of a Certified Local USBC Bowling Association affiliated with the NJS USBC are eligible to compete.
- 4. The Handicap will be 90 percent of the difference between the entering average and 230 in Singles and 460 in Doubles. There is no limit to the amount of handicap. This tournament shall be run as a handicap tournament for all three events, singles, doubles, and all events
- 5. There will be Seven Classes of competition in the Singles and All Events. Class A-1, 75 years and older; Class A70 years thru 74 years; Class B 65 years thru 69 years; Class C, 60 years thru 64 years; Class D, 55 years thru 59 years; Class E, 50 years thru 54 years; Class F,. 45 years thru 49 years. Entrants must verify age when checking in.
- 6. Doubles partners do not have to be from the same age group since there is only one class of competition in doubles
- 7. Entrants are eligible to compete in an unlimited amount of times in Singles & Doubles but may only cash once in Singles and Doubles (Highest Place). You may cash more than once in Doubles providing you change partners.
- 8. A Bowlers entering average will be the highest average, based on 21 games or more in a certified NJ USBC Local Association in the following order.(a) 2024-2025 winter season (b) 2025 summer season (c) 2023-2024 winter season (d) A bowler lacking (a thru c) must use a 230 average. Entrants must indicate appropriate letter after average on the front entry form.
- 9. An Entrant is responsible for the verification of their entering average, whether submitted by the bowler or someone else. Failure to use proper average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average thereby resulting in more handicaps. Prize winnings will be based on the submitted average if it IS higher than the actual average. In Doubles the averages will be combined to determine whether the correct total is higher or lower than the submitted total. Corrections in average may be made up to the completion of the first game of a series, or within 48 hours of completion of the series if, prior to completion of the first game, written consent is given by the ranking Tournament Official present in accordance with USBC Rule 319a4.
- 10. USBC Rule 319d will be waived in the event of anyone who has qualified for a cash and or merchandise prize of \$600.00 or more in any event of a tournament in the 12 month period prior to entry.
- 11. Any Entrant whose average must be adjusted under the provisions of USBC Rule 319e must report such adjusted average prior to bowling.
- 12. The 10 pin increase in current average USBC Rule 319a2 is waived.
- 13. All Events Champions in Classes A1, A, B, C, D and E are eligible to compete in the 2026 USBC Senior Championships. These winners are based on 35 or more entries in each Class and have their entry and shirt representing New Jersey paid for. If less than 35 entries, the winners are still entitled to go to the National Senior Championships but at their expense for entry and shirt. Class F bowlers are not eligible for the USBC Senior Championships which is limited to bowlers aged 50 years or older. If the first place All Events winner in any Class declines to bowl in the USBC Senior Championships the entry fee will revert back to the tournament expense fund. In the event of a tie for an entry to the Nationals in any class a three game roll off with handicap will be held to determine the entrant. If a tie still exists after three games and additional 9th and 10th frames will be bowled until the tie is broken.
- 14. Contestants will bowl only one event on a squad. A bowler entered in the Singles and doubles will be scheduled on two squads. Normally Singles will be scheduled before Doubles. Walk in entries will be allowed providing there is space available on that squad. A WALK IN FEE OF \$5.00 WILL BE ADDITIONALLY CHARGED TO THE ENTRANT. (Walk In fee is defined as paying for entrythe same day of the event
- 15. The Prize ratio in the Singles, Doubles and All Events shall be at least one in seven. USBC Rule 308 requires at least one in ten in Singles and Doubles and USBC Rule 306d requires at least one in twenty in All Events.
- 16. The Tournament Management will render on the spot decisions when required. All Tournament Management decisions shall be final except where an appeal is made to the USBC Headquarters.
