

Cruise southwest for approximately 1.5 hours to the Mamanuca Islands and anchor near Tavarua Island—known as the "heart-shaped island" and a world-renowned surfing destination with iconic breaks like Cloud break. Whether surfing or simply relaxing, this is the perfect 'post-card spot' to begin your island adventure.

Alternatively, explore the beautiful lagoon of Malolo Island, near Musket Cove Resort and Six Senses Fiji, with easy access to nearby surf breaks by tender.


DAY TWO

Dive Into Island Life at Malolo and Tavarua

Explore the stunning Malolo and Tavarua Islands at your own pace—whether surfing legendary waves, snorkeling vibrant coral reefs, or swimming in crystal-clear waters. The nearby sandbar is a tranquil oasis perfect for unwinding amid breathtaking scenery.

DAY THREE

Sailing to Navadra and Vanua Islands

After a morning swim or surf, set sail northwest for approximately three hours to the vibrant Navadra and Vanua Islands. Known for their pristine beaches and rich coral gardens—nicknamed the "Garden Reefs"—these islands offer exceptional snorkeling and the chance to participate in coral restoration projects. Weather permitting, we'll anchor here overnight or continue north for a short sail to South Waya Island, anchoring in the sheltered Yalobi Bay.

Enjoy a visit ashore to a nearby village, where local hosts warmly welcome you to explore their community and school, offering an authentic glimpse into island life.

DAY FOUR

Yalobi Bay to Naviti Island

Wake up surrounded by the calm waters of Yalobi Bay or Navadra Island. After a refreshing swim and breakfast, we'll cruise north for 1.5 hours to Cuvu Bay on Naviti Island.

This area is renowned for snorkeling and offers the rare chance to swim alongside graceful manta rays—majestic creatures that glide effortlessly through the water. Up to 13 manta rays have been seen here at once, creating a truly unforgettable experience. Along the way, we'll try our luck fishing to add fresh catch to your lunch.

We'll anchor in this beautiful spot or, if you prefer, continue north for 2 hours to the stunning Blue Lagoon near Nanuya Levu and Matacawa Islands.

DAY FIVE

The Blue Lagoon

Snorkeling here is breathtaking, with vibrant marine life and crystal-clear waters. We can anchor overnight or sail to nearby Sawa-i-Lau Island, renowned for its spectacular underwater caves. Swim through a small underwater tunnel guided by locals and explore the lagoon by scuba, kayak, or paddleboard. Don't miss the nearby shell markets ashore for a unique cultural touch.

Yasawa-i-Rara & Champagne Beach

After a morning swim and breakfast, we'll cruis 2 hours north to Yasawa-i-Rara, home to one of Fiji's most stunning beaches—Champagne Beach. Surrounded by dramatic mountain backdrops, the snorkeling here is exceptional, featuring vibrant hard and soft corals, turtles, reef sharks, and eagle rays.

Enjoy a beach BBQ in this idyllic setting before heading ashore for a traditional Meke dance performance and an authentic Kava ceremony, where guests present yaqona (kava root) to the village chief in a heartfelt custom.
