

MOVE-OUT AND CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

You are receiving this notice because, according to our records, you will be moving out at the end of July. We will not be doing in-person move-out inspections. Please thoroughly read through the instructions below to prepare for your move-out.

APARTMENT INSPECTIONS

To be ready for your inspection, all your belongings must be moved out of the apartment, and any cleaning must be completed by **July 26th at 8:00 am**. If you will be moving out prior to your lease expiration date, please return your keys to our office.

KEY RETURN

All keys must be returned to the HPM Office (105 S. 16th St, Ames) by 8:00 am on July 26th. We will have envelopes outside our front doors with a dropbox available to you, or in the main entryway during business hours for you to put your keys inside and label them with your address. There will be charges for any keys NOT returned by July 26th at 8:00 am. Do not leave your keys inside your unit.

PREPARING FOR YOUR INSPECTION

Make sure that the following has been done before your inspection:

- 1. Rent must be paid in full.
- 2. Empty your unit of all personal belongings.
- 3. Your unit should be cleaned using the attached checklist as a guide. Cleaning must be completed prior to July 26th.
- 4. Utilities for which you are responsible must be left in your name until your lease expires. This means if you leave a day or two early, you must have the meter read the day following the last day of your lease. Please contact utilities for a final reading at the end of your lease term.
- 5. All light bulbs and smoke detectors must be working.
- 6. If you have autopay set up to pull funds before the 30th of the month, please log in to your portal and cancel that before July 26th.

SECURITY DEPOSIT RETURNS

Deposits and/or itemization of retention of security deposits will occur within 30 days from your lease end date and from the time we have received your forwarding address and/or your bank information for an ACH.

You will receive an email requesting your bank account information. It is possible for one tenant to receive payment by ACH and the other by check. Each tenant needs to choose from one of the two options below:

- 1. You can provide your bank information, and we can return your security deposit via ACH payment directly to your account.
- 2. You can select 'NO' and we will issue a paper check, which will be mailed to you at your forwarding address.

We must receive all forwarding addresses before we can process your deposit return using the link below.

CLEANING THE CARPETS

Your carpets were cleaned when you moved in, and you are required to leave them in the same condition, less normal wear and tear. A receipt for carpet cleaning, returned with your keys, would meet that obligation.

CLEANING TIPS & TRICKS:

Certain cleaning products, when used properly, may make cleaning your home easier.

- 1. Murphy's Oil Soap with water is good for cleaning wood surfaces such as cabinets or doors.
- 2. Scrubbing Bubbles can help with cleaning soap scum from shower doors, tubs and sinks.
- 3. Windex can be used to clean the outside of appliances, mirrors, windows, or to shine any chrome fixtures or faucets.
- 4. Smooth cooktops should only use a glass ceramic cooktop cleaner such as Cerama-bryte or a similar product. If abrasive products are used, they may damage the stovetop.
- 5. Magic Erasers can help clean refrigerator shelves, dishwasher seals and built-up surfaces.
