EPISCOPAL CHURCH WOMEN SEEKS RUMMAGE SALE ITEMS - Episcopal Church Women (ECW) of St. Philip's Episcopal Church are having their 2nd Annual Rummage Sale set for Saturday, March 15th, from 8 a.m. to noon in the Church Fellowship Hall, and are seeking donations.

Donations for the sale can include toys, children's books only, jewelry, tools, kitchenware, linens (mark any linen with their dimensions), holiday decorations, glassware and utensils, pots and pans, serving pieces, sporting goods, un-upholstered furniture (stools, cabinets, bridge table and chairs etc.) and much more. Donations can be made Monday and Tuesday March 10 and 11th at the Fellowship Hall from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on both days.

This year, we are not accepting furniture, flat screen/smart TVs and electrical appliances. We cannot accept any live plants, artificial flowers/greenery, Christmas trees, clothing, mattresses, CDs/DVDs, tapes/records, other TVs or books (except children's books).
