Facilities Board – Dave Ham

- Storage space all over campus is being evaluated. Materials are being sorted to determine what will be kept and what will be donated/discarded around the entire campus. Room 201 will be used as a temporary storage location during this process. The team is getting together to organize and remove materials with each ministry board. The process is starting with the facilities board and then moving to other boards.
- Post Office yard is being cleaned up with removal of benches and other debris. The lobster cooker has been removed and disposed of in accordance with the wishes of the family that donated it.
- Chapel of the Cross spaces are being evaluated to accommodate for the Celtic Service. Ken Hagley (the door guy) is evaluating a solution that will return the front doors to just one lock that can be easily opened to allow quick exit from the building in accordance with fire codes. This will hopefully be complete before resumption of Celtic services
- The Memorial Garden committee is being reconstituted. Looking for additional members who know the history and have a willingness to help preserve it. Additional solutions are needed to accommodate spaces that have been oversold. Maybe using pavers along with gravesite markers.

Outreach Board – Liz Halbert

- Met with Bill Coffin (Finance Chair) to determine monies available from Outreach endowment to be distributed.
- SOIIF – the food bank is in a pinch and would appreciate extra donations.
- Diaper Ministry also have increased need, especially for wipes and creams.
- Brunswick Partnership for Housing (BPH) had a successful “sleep out” and raised over \$62,000 with a poverty simulation as well. Blue Cross/Blue Shield has awarded a \$75,000 grant to BPH.
- L'l Bit of help left for Belize yesterday and will be gone for 2 weeks. Will provide needs when they come back.
- ECW will be voting to determine the monies that will be given to Outreach.
- The Outreach board approved grant requests for \$5775 to Matthew's Ministry and \$7500 to Brunswick Partnership for Housing.
