### **Ministry Reports**

SOIICF – Food Pantry's use continues to increase. They served 1108 families and 1721 individuals. There was 35,476 pounds of food collected. They need help with the human needs' aspect of the pantry. They spent \$1529. 83 in human needs last month. Work is still going on for Day 4 Hope. They are looking for doctors and nurses to man the physical part of the event. Outreach will see how we can contribute once there is a more formal figuration of the event. Liz will be attending the next meeting to see where and what the needs are.

CIS Tutoring/Mentoring – Went well this year. Will continue next year.

Brunswick Partnership for Housing – All is going well. Graduated 2 families in 9 months. They have turned over the medical unit 3 times. Served 500 with outreach referrals and 240 nights of emergency shelter. They report the families have been great and have had no problems with damage to the units. They have had wonderful support from the community. They are in the process of planning Sleep Out Brunswick which will give people a chance to see what it is like to have little or nothing. Event goers will sleep outside and go to different stations of community, state, and local agencies to see if they can get help or are turned away. It is set for Oct 25, 2024 and hopefully will become a yearly event. The event is set to be held at the Cape Fear Regional Jetport. More information will follow.

ECW –The ministry gave \$500 to Men on a Mission for their help with the white elephant sale as a thank you for all their hard work.

for the entire 4<sup>th</sup> of July Celebration. Volunteers can park at the elementary school and take the shuttle to town so they can avoid the traffic.

- It was confirmed by members of ECW present, that the publicity and signage regarding the 2023 Fall Festival stated proceeds go to “St. Philips ministries.” This enables the distribution of total funds to remain 80% local and 20% international. All funds from the Outreach Endowment must be spent in Brunswick County.
- Grant from Samara’s Village: Sally gave the board an insight into the organization to help us better understand the finances of the organization. The Board voted to award the grant of \$5,000 with Deb Alt motioning and Sally Learned seconding. It passed the board with 7 yeas and 1 nay.
- Meals on Wheels Ministry is still in the work in progress stage. Checking with other groups in the church to see if volunteers are out there. The Board is looking to do it on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday of the month. Liz and Margaret will be going to see how it works and what will be involved and will report to the board next meeting. Will continue to discuss at next meeting.
