- Lay Eucharistic Visitors will be sent out from the altar at the conclusion of the service.

Deacon Pam Hayes –

- Reminded the ushers (through Steve Russell) to lock up and turn off lights.

Steve Russell – Ushers/Safety and Security

- Wants to schedule a mandatory usher training in January/February. Will check with the office for dates.
- Head ushers have 3 main jobs: 1) Welcoming; 2) Assist during the service, 3) Safety and security
- Ushers need reminding to greet people they do not know, not just people they do know.
- The presence of the police security does change some things.
- A discussion about locked vs. propped open doors followed.
- The discussion then moved to the Chapel to go over plans for the Celtic Service to be held there on Saturdays at 5:00 PM
- Steve's roles on Facilities board, worship board and safety and security board gives insight into the many facets of having a service at night in the Chapel of the Cross.
 - Much discussion followed including fire extinguishers, having a fire drill, installation of crash bars on the Chapel Doors, hiring off Duty management for security reasons, etc
