

From the desk of
Father Fidele O. Dikete....

Dear Parishioners and Friends,

We have initiated our third Advent week. The Advent Season focuses on four themes which are: Hope, Peace, Joy and Love . Each one of them is celebrated during the four weeks of Advent in preparation of the coming of the Lord. Our fourth and last week of Advent focuses on Love.

The birth of Jesus is the ultimate act of love. The son of God, being God, accepted to be born of the Virgin Mary and became a man. The mystery of incarnation should humble us to admire and thank God for this amazing gift of His begotten and only son Jesus.

Jesus told the disciples of John the Baptist who came to see him and asked a fundamental question: "Are you the one who is to come, or should we look for another?" Jesus responded to them by saying: "Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them (Matthew 11:2-11). I invite you to see and hear the good that is taking place in our community and challenge you to be the sign to those who are wondering, like John Baptist, on the identity of Jesus, Emmanuel, God is with us."

As the Angel of the Lord told Joseph in today's Gospel, to not be afraid and trust in God. Make a difference during this Christmas season in your life and in the life of those around you.

I thank each one of you who participated in our spiritual activities this past week: Reconciliation Service, Christmas Party, Santa Claus distributing gifts to the children of our community and Las Posadas. You are encouraged to continue participating in our spiritual activities, especially the two Holy Days of obligation, the Nativity of our Lord and the Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God. Please make a special effort to attend and participate in all the celebrations.

I thank all the Knights of Columbus for providing a delicious breakfast to all the children and families of our Religious Education Program and all the parishioners that attended the 8:00 am morning mass this past Sunday.

We have added two Holy Water fonts at both entrance doors. Two additional Holy Water fonts have been placed also on each side of both side doors. It is very humbly and excitedly that I announce to you that our goal has been reached! My Christmas wish list has been granted! As of today, Sunday, December 21st, we have collected a total close to \$8,175 towards the purchase of 2 processional candles. The cost for each candle is \$2,470 for a total of \$4,940 for both candles. We have exceeded our expectations and will also use the remaining money toward a new Processional cross.

Thank you to everyone who donated toward this project. I am very grateful for your generosity and willingness to continue honoring the House of the Lord with sacred ornaments.

My Christmas letter will be made available for everyone on Christmas Day. I invite you to get excited and pray for the Mystery of the Incarnation, as God becomes one of us.

SACRAMENTS

Baptism
Baptism serves as the first Sacrament one receives when entering the Catholic Faith. You only receive it one time as your Sacrament of Initiation.

To schedule a Baptism, please call the parish office to begin the process.

- **First Communion and Confirmation:** Students must be enrolled in Religious Education classes for two consecutive years. First Communion normally takes place during the 2nd grade year and Confirmation during the 10th grade year, exceptions may be arranged. Baptism is a prerequisite! Call the office to get your child baptized before classes begin.
- **Marriage:** By Appointment - Six Months in Advance! Call the parish office to register, turn in necessary documents and arrange appointments with the Pastor.
- **Sacrament of the Sick or Holy Communion for the Homebound:** Call to arrange the time and location. Office: (210) 635-8539
- **Funerals:**
 1. First contact should be the funeral home, they will contact the parish office to schedule the services.
 2. After meeting with the funeral home, call the office to schedule a family meeting with the Pastor.
