The Facility:

The Adirondack Experience is an extensive museum complex of buildings perched above Blue Mountain Lake in the Adirondacks of New York. The museum houses over a collection of over 130,000 objects pertaining to the history of life in the Adirondack region. The museum carries an ongoing mission to expand the public understanding of Adirondack history and the relationship between people and the Adirondack wilderness.

Nature of Services:

Master Planning

Landmark Facilities Group, Inc. participated in a study of the existing mechanical systems in the museum's many buildings. The assessment included recommendations for improving and repairing the systems on a short and long-term basis. The assessment became part of a campus master plan that is guiding improvement and expansion decisions.

Environmental Improvements

Landmark Facilities Group, Inc. engineered a replacement climate control system for the Life in the Adirondacks building at the Adirondack Experience. The project involved the replacement of comfort air-handling units with new modular air-handling units capable of museum-level temperature and humidity control. Along with the air-handling unit replacement, the firm designed a new high-efficiency boiler plant, a new chilled water plant, and a new emergency generator to carry the electric load for the whole building.
