Highland Park:

Conveniently located on a high plateau that straddles Queens and Brooklyn, Highland Park offers stunning views of surrounding neighborhoods, the ocean, and nearby cemeteries.

Acquired in pieces over time, the park took its present shape between 1906 and 1908, it quickly became a popular spot among residents of both boroughs, and continues to play an important role in the community.

Nature of Firm's Responsibilities:

Landmark Facilities Group, Inc. was commissioned to provide master planning strategies for adaptive reuse of this Brooklyn reservoir as a public facility. Several buildings on the site are being considered for restoration and new facilities are planned for parking and recreational use. There is a new ball field planned and an ecosystem walkway thru the tree canopy above a swampy portion of the site. One third of the reservoir cells is retained for water distribution use.
