Dianna's story: "As soon as I saw the stick that said positive, I was freaking out. I genuinely thought that my life was over. I was just lost, really and I didn't know what to do. So, I spent a lot of sleepless nights just crying.

I was a student double majoring in criminal justice and psychology with a

year left. Coming so far, I felt like I was just a disappointment. I had already decided in my mind, I was gonna abort it. And I thought, "what if I just don't

tell anyone and I just terminate, nobody would know."

So I was looking into Planned Parenthood. Then I went online to see other abortion clinics and Informed Choices came up and I made an appointment. I was told they would help me with classes and materials for me and my baby. I felt a sigh of relief - like so much weight had been lifted off my shoulders. When I saw the ultrasound, I saw like a little bean with a little heartbeat. I knew once I left this office that I was gonna keep it.

If I didn't find Informed Choices, I definitely would have just gone to Planned Parenthood and regretting it, honestly – going through with the abortion. I genuinely feel like **Informed Choices saved that decision - saved the baby's life really.**



MINISTRY PARTNERS EVENTS

In 2024, our ministry partners came together to support life through two impactful events: Hike for Life and our Annual Banquet. Hike for Life brought families, friends, and supporters together for a day of community, advocacy, and fundraising. The Annual Banquet provided a powerful evening of inspiration, connection, and generosity, fueling our mission to serve and support women and families. These events not only strengthened our partnerships but also played a vital role in sustaining the life-affirming work of Informed Choices.









DEAR MINISTRY PARTNERS

Leading Informed Choices means holding that same perspective—keeping an eye on the changing landscape of women seeking abortion while remaining firmly grounded in our mission.


This year, as our ministry has grown, we've stretched in new ways, experiencing both challenges and exciting progress that have strengthened our ability to serve women, men, and families.

Key Milestones 2024:

- Installed new ultrasound machines in both centers, giving expectant parents a clearer picture of their growing baby and its heartbeat.
- Upgraded IT security and phone systems to safeguard confidentiality and improve responsiveness.
- Transitioned to EveryLife diapers, a pro-life company aligning with our values.
- Became the first Illinois pregnancy center to partner with Infinite Worth, offering 24/7 nurse support via text to connect with women seeking our services.
- Increased medical appointment availability in Grayslake to four days per week.

These efforts resulted in a **114.7% increase in medical appointments since 2020** and a decrease in the "No Show" rate.

- Hire a part-time nurse in Crystal Lake.
- Train additional volunteer advocates—both women and men.
- Explore ways to better serve Spanish-speaking clients.



While we celebrate these achievements, we also recognize that not everyone supports the lifeaffirming education and care we provide. Some



have gone so far as to protest outside our center. Yet, despite opposition, we remain steadfast in our mission to offer hope, truth, and practical support to those facing unplanned pregnancies.

These milestones reflect how Informed Choices is evolving to serve with greater excellence and compassion. I am filled with gratitude for our team, volunteers, and supporters who make it possible to walk alongside so many women and families.

I am excited about the future of Informed Choices and what God has in store for this ministry. Together, we are helping couples journey from panicked to prepared—from considering abortion to becoming confident parents and thriving families.




