

#### A LETTER FROM OUR EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR



2020 has certainly been a challenging year, yet we can clearly see how God's care, provision, and protection for Informed Choices has not wavered. When businesses and schools were forced to close, our pregnancy centers remained

open. Our staff continued to answer the calls, provide pregnancy tests, options education and ultrasounds. In retrospect, we know that God had been preparing our ministry to serve women and men during a pandemic, ensuring His work was still carried out.

When we completed the remodel of our Crystal Lake location in March. we realized that the new client room was the only room large enough to maintain the required 6-foot social distancing to continue meeting in person with abortion vulnerable women.

The recent implementation of Bright Course, an online streaming service allowed us to provide parenting education remotely, when we were not able to have pregnant women and new parents visit our centers. We were able to send links and follow up by phone to maintain a connection with our clients. In fact, we had more parents participate than before Covid!

Managing all those remote learning classes and follow-up, was handled by our new Client Care Coordinators. The hiring of these two women had our ministry adequately staffed to handle this adjustment to how we offer services.

As I look back at 2020 with the pandemic and civil unrest, I think about how we all faced circumstances that we didn't plan. Circumstances that brought uncertainty, perhaps fear or panic, and a desire that our lives would just go back to normal. These are many of the same feelings a young woman experiences when facing an unplanned pregnancy. With the prayers and support of ministry partners like you, Informed Choices is committed to being here for her at that critical time she learns she is pregnant. To sit

with her when all she can see is the negative and speak hope into her circumstance. To help her identify her strengths and see possibility. To encourage her to look at her situation with the future in mind and carefully weigh this decision that will forever change her life. As we do, we pray her life will be transformed as we point her to God, pray with her, and walk with her through this journey.

All of this work was possible because of you, our faithful ministry partners.

Thank you for your prayers and encouragement. Thank you for generously supporting us through this difficult year. As we remember how God has led us through 2020, we can step with confidence into 2021, knowing that no matter what challenges Informed Choices may face, God will see us through. "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand." Isaiah 41:10



Only five months from graduation, K's plans did not include pregnancy. Yet, that's exactly what happened. Faced with peer pressure (her friend had 3 past abortions and was encouraging K towards that decision) as well as uncertainty about the relationship with the baby's father, she began researching methods of abortion. During her initial appointment at Informed Choices, K was able to talk about her concerns and get information about abortion procedures and risks. After weeks of indecision that included scheduling and canceling an abortion multiple times, K decided to carry her baby. She began our Prep for Life online classes and continued talking with an advocate as her pregnancy progressed.





### **NEW LIFE RESALE**

Like so many businesses, our two New Life Resale locations were forced to close for 3 months due to Covid. When we were able to reopen, many of our dedicated volunteers came right back to help process donations and serve our customers. In fact, together they served 9,446 hours!

Due to the pandemic and related closure, we experienced a reduction in total donations and customer traffic. We are grateful that we were able to recoup most of those losses by year end.








#### **MEN'S LIFE**

### **HEALTHY CHOICES**

2020 started off with our busiest year yet for Healthy Choices. We were blessed to add in 3 new schools and were double and sometimes triple booked each week through the end of the school year. The unthinkable happened when schools shut down on March 13, 2020 due to Covid19. We were able to film some lessons for our 8th grade classes on building healthy relationships and several of our schools used them during their spring remote learning. Over the summer we had no idea what would happen come fall but we prepared by filming several of our "hands on" classroom activities outside with my own daughter and several of her friends. We were so thankful to start teaching remotely mid September! The Healthy Choices team has adapted very well to remote learning. We are very blessed to be able to continue partnering with many of our schools. The health teachers and students are excited and thankful to "see" us each week. Even with the spring shut down, the Healthy Choices team still worked with 4237 Students and did 866 Presentations in 11 schools during 2020!!
