## MEN'S LIFE

Informed Choices continues to encourage men to take an active role in the pregnancy decision he is facing with his partner. We strive to include him in the initial visit, the ultrasound, options education and decision-making process. Fathers who choose to parent are encouraged to participate in our healthy pregnancy education, as well as parenting education specifically for fathers. Our Bright Course program has 11 lessons called Being a Father, which talks about what he can do to become a loving father who provides guidance and support – the kind of father their child needs. This information, along with one-on-one conversations with a Men's Life volunteer can equip men for their new role as dad.

# HIKE FOR LIFE RAISED \$61,664

We ran ads to reach the 37,000 area college students. And we are happy to share that IC was able to pay off the balance of our last remaining Center mortgage!

With your continued support and prayers, we are excited to begin another year of ministry. Please be praying God will lead people to serve with us in 2022, so that our Centers will be fully staffed and fully trained to walk with clients throughout their pregnancy journey.



Twenty-nine year old Felicia was in her last year of college and working towards a career in social work when she found out she was pregnant. During her first appointment at Informed Choices, she learned about all her options and received an ultrasound.



Felicia said, "I was going to have an abortion, but changed my mind just by coming here and talking it through. Hearing it out loud, I don't want to do that - it doesn't sound like me. I was making an irrational decision. Having someone not judging, just listening...it kinda helped me realized that's not what I wanted. I was doing it out of fear. And now that I have support and someone to talk to about things, I can do this. I'm stronger than I thought I was. I'm gonna get my life together, figure out things I need to do to be successful, and make sure my baby is well taken care of."

For Felicia, that included regular appointments at Informed Choices to learn about labor & delivery, breastfeeding, and infant care so when her daughter, Xamora, was born Felicia felt well equipped to be a mom.
