



Parent/Guardian Expectations Contract

Parents and guardians are an integral part of the Chattanooga Red Wolves Academy support system. All parents/guardians are expected to observe and uphold the standards, policies, and guidelines established by the Club, leagues, and governing bodies.

The following expectations and standards will apply to all Red Wolves Academy teams and families beginning with the 2026–2027 seasonal year.

Our goal is to create a positive, respectful, competitive, and development-focused environment for every player. Families who fail to uphold these standards may be subject to disciplinary action by the Club, including impacts to playing time, team participation, financial standing, sideline privileges, and/or membership within the organization.

As a Parent, I Will...

- Be encouraging, supportive, and positive regarding my child's participation and development on the field
- Demonstrate respect toward referees and accept their decisions appropriately
- Support the coaches, managers, players, and the team environment
- Volunteer my time, services, and talents to support the Club whenever possible
- Familiarize myself with the Laws of the Game and promote good sportsmanship
- Comply with all team, club, league, and governing body policies, procedures, and expectations
- Communicate appropriately regarding my child by:
 - Speaking directly with the coach only
 - Not discussing concerns with managers, other parents, or players
 - Scheduling conversations at a mutually agreed-upon time
 - Never approaching a coach before, during, or immediately after a game
- Encourage my child to demonstrate respect, accountability, discipline, and teamwork at all times

As a Parent, I Will Never...

- Engage in dissent or negative behavior directed toward referees or officials
- Use abusive, inappropriate, or unsportsmanlike language or conduct toward any official, coach, manager, player, or parent
- Coach from the sidelines or interfere with the responsibilities of coaches or managers
- Create conflict, division, or negativity within the team or club environment
- Act in any way that is detrimental to the players, team, or Chattanooga Red Wolves Academy
