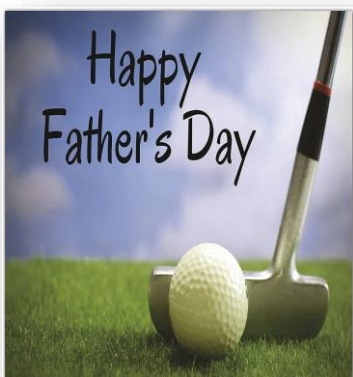

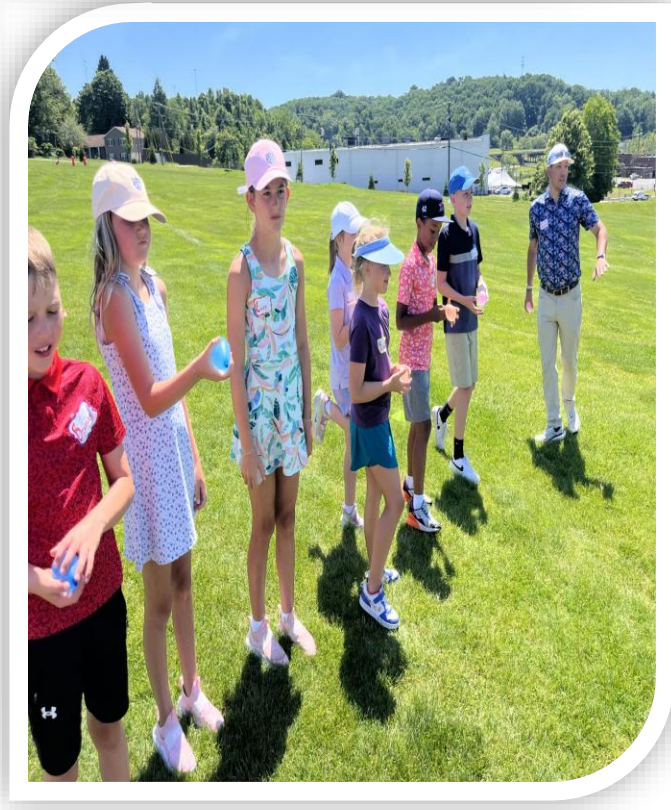

Pool News

Summer is Here!

Please remember to bring your pool pass with you, and sign in any guest accompanying you. Guests are welcome to visit our pool up to 5 times and **MUST** be accompanied by the member they are signing in under.

Any member sending children with a babysitter must purchase a babysitter pass from Christine (in the office).

Babysitter passes are not a substitute for a guest pass and may only be used when parents aren't accompanying the children.

On days the pool closes for inclement weather, it will be announced on the Bridgeport Country Club FB page/ Instagram, and if possible, an email will be sent out. If the weather is questionable, we encourage you to check FB or call before heading out!

Anyone interested in private swim lessons may ask any of the Lifeguards or contact Kolby Alonso at 304-669-9234. Private Lessons are \$20.00/half hour.

Pool parties this year can be scheduled between the hours of 5:30 and 8:00 pm. on Tuesdays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays. You can schedule a pool party by contacting Julie in Food and Beverage.

Please remember some of our pool rules that were added in the past few years:

- No smoking on the pool deck of any kind
- No outside food or drink is permitted in the pool area (Mondays and parties included with the exception of cake)
- Diaper changes are to be made in the restrooms only
- Small pool toys get lodged in the filter and can cause issues, no small pool toys are permitted
- Small children must be accompanied by an adult into the restrooms
- Children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult to the pool
- No oversized floatation devices will be permitted
- No personal coolers are permitted
- No glass of any kind is allowed on the pool deck
- Pool beer coolers may not leave the pool area. They will be numbered and **MUST** be returned before guests leave for the day.



We kindly ask all families to help us create a safe, respectful, and enjoyable environment for everyone. Parents and guardians are responsible for supervising their children and ensuring they follow basic pool manners and etiquette. Children should use respectful language, follow all lifeguard instructions, avoid running on the pool deck, and be mindful of other members who are there to relax and enjoy their time. Please remind children to clean up after themselves, treat furniture and pool equipment with care, and show courtesy to fellow members and staff.

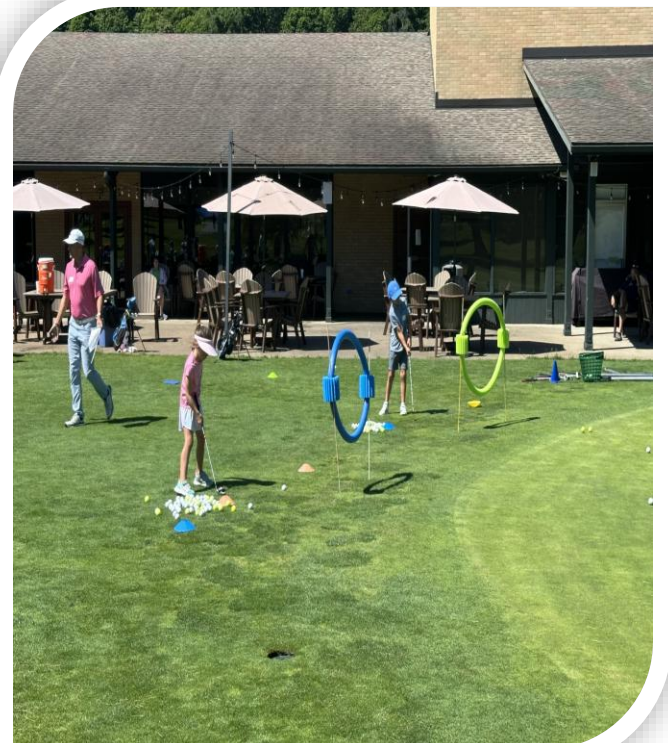

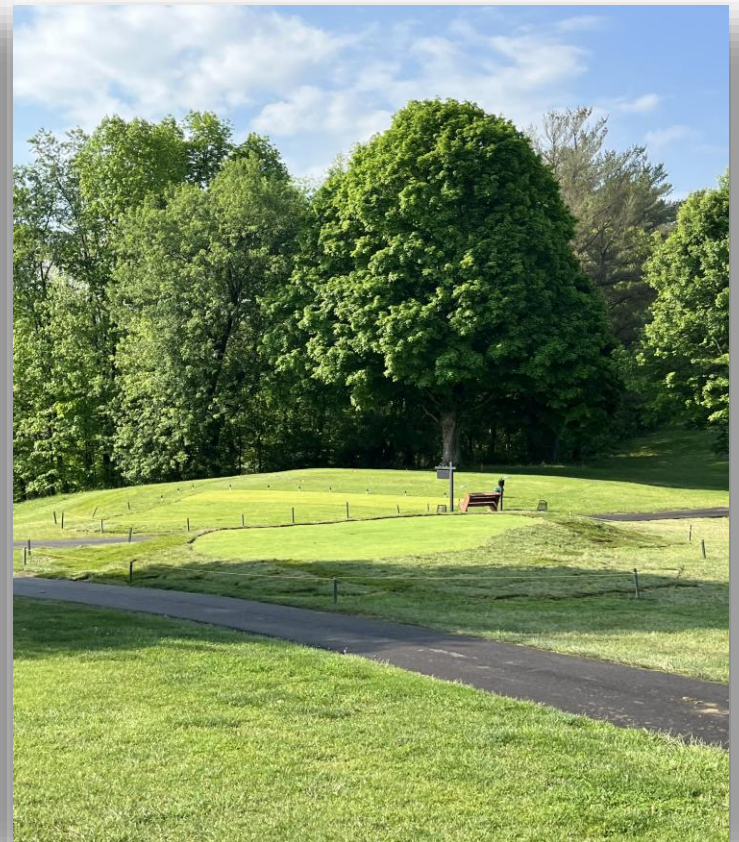

Please be careful as this sod is still taking root and can easily be damaged or rutted up. Just a friendly reminder to replace divots, repair ball marks, and rake footprints out in bunkers.

GOLF COURSE RULES/ETIQUETTE

The golf season is in full swing and with such, our club golf course is busy. This newsletter section on Golf Etiquette, is just a friendly reminder that touches on how to take care of your Club Golf Course and fellow members and their guests. It is by no means exhausts everything that would be considered appropriate or polite at the Club.

PRIOR TO PLAY: Please call the Golf Shop or book a Tee-Time online. Even if you are on your way to the Club. This helps the staff with preparedness, and allowing us to better serve you and your guests.

CHECK IN: Please check in with the Golf Shop prior to play or when utilizing the range.

MONDAY GOLF: BCC is closed for golf on Mondays until 1:00pm to allow our maintenance staff to perform necessary maintenance on our golf course. Members may walk the course after 1:00pm when there is not an Outside Outing that closes the course. These outings will be posted on the bulletin board and on the website. The bag room, golf shop and locker room will not be accessible on Mondays. If you store your clubs, you must get them during regular golf shop hours.

Any guests playing on Mondays must be with a member and must be registered with the golf shop. You can do this in advance by calling the golf shop during regular hours or leaving a message on the voicemail to register your guests. You must state your name, member number and the full name of the guest playing as well as the number of holes playing. All appropriate green fees will be charged to the member's account for any guest play on Mondays.

PACE OF PLAY: BCC culture embodies a brisk pace of play. Everyone is expected to complete their round in four hours or less. Remember that your place on the course is immediately behind the group in front of you, not immediately in front of the group behind you.

CONSIDERATION FOR OTHER PLAYERS: No one should move, talk or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke. No player should play until the players in front are out of range (being hit by a golf ball is never fun).

GOLF CART RULES:

- Do not drive the cart within 30 yards of the green; never drive between bunker and green.
- Keep carts on path around all tee boxes and on all Par 3's
- Avoid accumulated water or soft turf areas.
- No more than 2 players and 2 sets of clubs may be carried on a cart (unless approved by the Golf Professional staff).
- Must have a valid Driver's License to operate a golf cart

BUNKER ETIQUETTE: Prior to entering the bunker, locate the low point which is where you should enter and exit. Never jump in or jump out using the grass face as a step. Sometimes taking the rake into the bunker with you, can help avoid creating extra work during the raking process. Once you've hit your shot, rake the sand in a manner to eliminate footprints, leaving the sand in a condition that you yourself would like to find it. Lastly, when placing the rakes, the handle should be placed on the bunker edge, with the remainder of the rake inside the bunker. This will prevent the golf ball from coming to rest against the rake.

DIVOT REPAIR: Repairing your divots is fundamental to maintaining good course conditions and good golf etiquette; you *always* want to do your best to leave the course better than you found it. Replacing your divots shows that you care about keeping the golf course in good shape and helps maintain the golf course.

BALL MARK REPAIR: Repairing ball marks is another cornerstone in golf etiquette. Always carry a repair tool and quickly fix ball marks on the green to be flat. Fixing any additional marks, is also encouraged, if applicable. If you have any questions on how to repair a ball mark, please connect with one of the BCC Professional Staff members.

PLAYING PRIORITY: Foursomes have priority. If you have a twosome, you do not have priority on the golf course; if it is possible for the foursome to let a twosome play through the foursome will follow proper etiquette. If you tee off the back nine, you do not have priority on the front nine. You must get in line behind the groups teeing off number one. All players must the Golf Shop's permission to tee off #10.

****5-somes are allowed at the Golf Shop's discretion****

SAFETY: When playing a stroke or making a practice swing make sure no one is standing close by or in a position to be hit by the club. Always yell "fore" if your ball is hit toward another golfer, as this gives the person time to cover their head.

TEE SELECTION: Pick the tees that best match your playing skill level and yardages. Too many golfers feel they have to play the longest set of tees, even if they are not capable of playing easily and comfortably from those tees. If in doubt, pick the set of tees you would normally play and then play one set lower.

READY GOLF: Play ready golf throughout your entire round. The term "Ready golf" means that whoever in the group is ready to play, hits, even if it is not their turn to play. ****Do not take an inordinate number of practice swings.****

PLAYING YOUR SHOT: Do not stand over your ball for a long period of time before making your shot: *Walter Hagen, the famous golfer during the 1920's, coined the best phrase for this philosophy: "Miss it quick".*

MOVING ON: Leave the green immediately upon completion of the hole: Mark the scores for the hole on the way to the next teeing area. Do not practice putt on the green if the next tee is open or a group is waiting behind you.

ON COURSE PRACTICE: Do not take practice shots OR mulligans during play.

These are simple reminders to help everyone's experience at Bridgeport Country Club, live up to its history of one of the premier private clubs in West Virginia.
