The "Tournament Cards 2026" have all the details needed to pay and sign up. To play, send in **ONE** check **PER** tournament, **BEFORE** the due dates. (10 days prior to the tournaments) IF POSSIBLE, send in ONE check for your entire group. If you do not have a foursome, I will do my best to add members to your group and fill available spots. Single golfers are welcome to sign up. Some Tournaments will have TEE TIMES, some still have a shotgun start. SEE FORMS for details and please fill out completely before sending them in.

The Maine Seniors Championship and Annual Meeting (including Dinner) will be held at the Portland Country Club Monday July 27th, 2026, regardless of weather. **NO REFUNDS.** Tee Times at 7:45 am and 1:00 pm (shot-gun start). Active members only.

Prizes: We have one overall individual gross and net winner. We have 4 flight winners (1 gross and 3 net) based on age, and 3 team winners using a Stableford format.

To get to Golf Genius, sign up forms, etc..

1. I will e-mail the tee sheet one week prior to the tournament, and results (after the round) to all participants. Local Papers will **NO LONGER** carry results.
2. I will try to accommodate requests for tee times but **no** guarantees. It NOT first comes, first serve.
3. If there is a rain out, it will be posted on this web site as soon as I know. I will also email those registered in case of a rain delay or cancellations. Keep an eye on your Email.

Scoring and FAQ's

1. There will be pre-printed score cards upon your arrival which **MUST** be turned in at the end of your round.
2. **I will** post scores to GHIN.
3. Please inform me if you have a cancellation or a substitution in your group. If a substituted player doesn't have an active GHIN, or he is a guest, he may play but will not be eligible to win prizes.
4. A computer generated "blind draw" will be utilized for groups that have fewer than 4 players.
5. Handicaps pulled from GHIN on the Sunday before our tournaments, will be utilized.
6. **Captains** are responsible for score cards, pace of play, and team communications.
7. IF events are oversubscribed, a computer blind draw will determine who plays.

Cost & Refunds

"Active" members pay \$95.00 per tournament. See forms for details.

"Wait List" Applicants and Guests pay \$105.00_per tournament.

"Refunds". There will be **NO** refund if you cancel less than **5 days** prior to the tournament. If you cancel, try to find your replacement so you don't lose your fee. E-mail maineseniors1932@gmail.com as The Tournament Director (Dave) **may** be able to help.

Each club will have a "closest to the pin" contest run through their Pro-shop (at a \$5.00 cost) if you are interested. They usually pay 2 winners for every par three. Please support our Pro-Shops!
