Advent "Kristkindl": Tell your children about the German custom of "Kristkindl". (Christ child) Explain that during Advent, the name of each family member is written on a slip of paper, folded, and put into a container. Then each family member picks a slip of paper at random, and the person named on the slip becomes his/her "Kristkindl" as a gift to Jesus.


