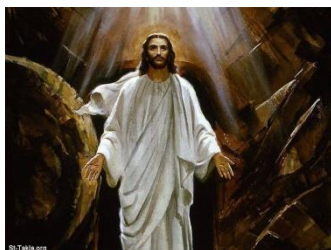


EASTER

Did you know that Easter is not just a one day celebration! Easter is an entire season where we celebrate our new life in Christ. It is actually a seven-week season of the church year called Eastertide, the Great Fifty Days that begins at sundown the evening before Easter Sunday (the Easter Vigil) and lasts for six more Sundays until Pentecost Sunday. During these fifty days of Easter we relive the joyous events of the Glorious Mysteries of the Holy Rosary: the Resurrection, Ascension, and the coming of the Holy Spirit on Mary and the Apostles at Pentecost.
