New Life Church was established with the goal of changing lives in St Louis Metro East communities. To that end, we as LifeChangers have established a scholarship program to help deserving high school graduates change their lives and, in turn, change the lives of others. New Life will award twelve (12) scholarships, totaling \$30,000 to deserving students that demonstrate academic excellence, exemplify sound moral character, and portray the wholistic characteristics that are the mission of our ministry.

1. Please carefully read and follow all instructions printed:
 - a. Each applicant may apply for only ONE scholarship.
 - b. Complete the [2026 New Life Scholarship Online Application](https://thisismynewlife.com/scholarship) at thisismynewlife.com/scholarship and upload all required supporting documents in PDF format for the scholarship you are applying for. See NLC Scholarship Application Checklist for complete list of required supporting documents.
 - c. Submit your official transcript in a sealed envelope with the school's seal, and the applicant's full name on the upper right corner to:

 - d. The [online scholarship application](#) must be completed, and official transcript **received at the NLC church office no later than 4:00pm CST, Thursday, February 19, 2026**. Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.
2. Cumulative GPA should be provided based on an unweighted 4.0 scale (convert numerical or letter grades). Also, when providing cumulative GPA, be sure that your most recent term is included (i.e., Fall 2025).
3. All transcripts must be **certified/official** copies with SAT or ACT scores reflected. See NLC Scholarship Application Checklist for complete details.

Requirements for this Scholarship Only

- **Minimum 3.5 GPA** (submit official academic transcript)
- SAT or ACT score(s) (submit copy of official test scores)
- 450-500 word essay (see “Scholarship Essay” requirements on)
- Interview (will be considered after applicant has submitted and met all requirements)
- SUPPORTING DOCUMENT W/ PACKET Two (2) letters of recommendation **signed**
- Community involvement/service (indicated on Student Personal BIO or Statement)

The Bishop Geoffrey V. Dudley, Sr. Pastoral Scholarship of Excellence Essay Topic

New Life in Christ church demonstrates excellence through our core values of Welcome, Worship, Word and Witness. How have you demonstrated excellence in your life? How do you plan to demonstrate excellence in your core values after high school and effectively incorporate it into a life of excellence, integrity, and civic- mindedness. (450-500 words)

The John H. McCants Hope Memorial Scholarship

The John H. McCants Hope Memorial Scholarship is so named for Bro. John H. McCants, a charter member of NLC who was instrumental in the church’s beginnings. It is a need-based scholarship established to offer hope where there is despair; open doors of opportunity that may be otherwise closed, and give a hand up, not a handout. The additional requirement for this scholarship is proof of a financial need. See **Requirements above *** ADDITIONAL Requirements**

- Verification from your high school that states you are currently enrolled in 12th grade and meet any one of the indicators of economic need listed **1)** *enrolled in the free or reduced-priced lunch program;* **2)** *participates in a program for economically disadvantaged students;* **3)** *resides in a foster home, is a ward of the state, is homeless* **OR** *family receives low-income public assistance.*

The John H. McCants Hope Memorial Scholarship Essay Topic

Hope is defined as wanting or wishing for something with a feeling of confident expectation. In your own words, describe what is meant by the expression “to hope against hope”. Provide at least one example from your own experience where you had to hope against hope as well as how you plan to offer hope after college. (300-350 words)

The Minister Sheila Renee Swygert Memorial Scholarship

The Minister Sheila Renee Swygert Memorial Scholarship is established in memory of the first LifeChanger to exchange time for eternity. This scholarship is awarded to the individual who has, through perseverance and persistence, overcome their circumstances despite the odds. **Requirements above *****

The Minister Sheila Renee Swygert Memorial Scholarship Essay Topic

Minister Swygert overcame adversity in her life through persistence and perseverance. Describe an instance in which you had to overcome adversity. Include the outcome and the effect it had on your life and how it has prepared you for your life after high school and college. (300-350 words)

Bishop Leamon & Ida Dorothy Dudley Memorial Scholarship

The Bishop Leamon & Ida Dorothy Dudley Memorial Scholarship is established in memory of the mother and father of our Bishop Geoffrey V. Dudley, Sr. Mrs. Dudley was an avid reader and a great lover of music. Most importantly, this powerful woman of GOD exhibited the “Barnabas” spirit. His father Bishop Leamon Dudley was a leader among men. He was also an advocate for training and education. **Requirements above *****

The Chyriell Drain Hill Memorial Scholarship

The Chyriell Drain Hill Memorial Scholarship Fund, in partnership with New Life Church, will award to those individuals who exemplify the characteristics of wanting to be helpful, showing a tendency towards sociability, displaying warmth towards others and are concerned with the welfare of all humankind. **Requirements above *****

The Gerald T. Washington Memorial Scholarship

The Gerald T. Washington Memorial Scholarship commemorates the life of LifeChanger Bro. Gerald T. Washington. He was the Vice-President for Institutional Advancement in five Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU). He also assisted four more HBCUs with grant writing and institutional gifts. **This scholarship is reserved for African American students who plan to attend an HBCU. Requirements above *****

Briefly describe why you wish to attend an HBCU. Describe how your values, qualities, and skills will flourish at an HBCU as well as how attending an HBCU will make an impact in your life and career. (300-350 words)

The New Life Church LifeChanger Scholarships

The Ernest Cotton Memorial Scholarship

The Ernest Cotton Memorial Scholarship commemorates the life of LifeChanger Bro. Ernest Cotton. Earnest believed in sowing into the lives of young men. As a professional athlete who went to college on an athletic scholarship he wanted to give back to other young men to be able to use their abilities to fund their education. **This scholarship is reserved for African American male students who plan to attend a traditional college OR pursue a technical trade certification track. Requirements above *****

- o Essay should be typed or computer-generated using a **12-pt. font and double-spaced**. Place word count in the footer of the Word or Google document. **"My essay word count is: _____"**
- o **Submit the essay as a PDF document**

☐ **Official High School Academic Transcript**

- o All transcripts must be certified/official copies with SAT or ACT scores reflected and should be:
 - Submitted in a sealed envelope, stamped with the school seal. Transcript requests, that involve a 3rd party vendor, are still the applicant's responsibility to ensure the transcripts are **postmarked on OR received at the NLC church office no later than 4:00pm CST, Thursday, February 19th, 2026** for application to be **considered complete. Mail delivery is strongly discouraged.**
