First Lady and I are back from our first-ever sabbatical, and before I share anything about what God taught me, I want to say THANK YOU!

Thank you to Pastors Mohagany and Travis for their strong pastoral leadership in my absence. Thank you to our Vision Board for insisting that I take this sabbatical. Thank you to our day staff, ministry leaders, clergy and diaconate staff for continuing the work of ministry with excellence. And especially, thank you to ALL of the LifeChangers who loved First Lady and me enough to embrace our absence and give us the space to truly step away, rest and hear from God.

Now the **lessons!** For most of my life, I have known how to DO—preach, lead, build, teach, serve, solve problems and make decisions. What I discovered during my sabbatical is that while I knew how to work—and even knew how to vacation—I had never really learned how to stop!

During this time, God taught me seven lessons.

I learned that Sabbath is more than taking a day off; it is trusting God enough to stop. **I learned** that busyness could hide what is happening in your soul and that vacation and genuine rest are not the same thing.

I learned to stop reading the Bible only for everybody else and start asking, “Jesus, what are You saying to me?” Before I am a preacher, I am a disciple. Before I am a leader, I am a follower.

I learned that regret (that I never did this before) cannot give me yesterday back, but what God teaches me today can change how I live tomorrow. **I was reminded** that after decades of ministry, leadership and life, I am still under construction. And finally, **I learned** that every question does not have to be answered. Sometimes we simply need to become quiet long enough to listen—to God, to our family, to our bodies, to our thoughts and to our souls.

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So, **LifeChangers**, I'm back...but I don't want to come back the same. And I am not going to! I want to pray differently. Read Scripture differently. Rest differently. Lead differently. Live differently. And perhaps there is something in these seven lessons for you too, so...

One More Step by Howard Murray

September is here and with it comes a reminder of the importance of hope in our lives. Romans 15:13 says, "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in Him." This verse speaks to our very human need to for reassurance and motivation. Who is this God of Hope? He is El Ha Tikvah (Hebrew). This is just another way that God shows up for us. You are familiar with various names of God: Jehovah Nissi (God, our Banner), Jehovah Shalom (God, our Peace), or Jehovah Rapha (God, our Healer) and so forth, right? Bruh, you need to know the God of Hope.

Have you ever been working towards something and **hit a wall**? You're putting in the work. You're working your plan, but you can't see any progress. You may even be moving backwards! When that happens, doubt may creep in. You may be tempted to throw in the towel. That is when you need to call on **The God of Hope**.

Hope is that gas that your spiritual engine needs to keep moving forward even when you can't see the path. Your faith is built up by what God has brought you through (rearview mirror). Hope is what is needed for the destination God is bringing you to (windshield).

Smokie Norful's song, **I Understand**, puts it this way.

*"Sometimes I feel like giving up....It seems like my best just ain't good enough
Lord if you hear me, I'm calling you....Do you see, do you care all about what I'm going through
And then He says, one more day hmm, one more step...See I'm preparing you for myself
And when you can't hear my voice, please trust my plan...I'm the Lord, I see and yes I understand"*

Yes, life can throw curveballs that will leave you feeling stuck or disheartened. But here's the reality: God sees you, and He is always working, even when you can't perceive it as progress. He is orchestrating every detail and crafting a plan that is uniquely yours (Jer. 29:11). He has already walked out all of your days (Ps. 139:16)! So, when you can't hear His voice, continue to trust His plan for your life and take one more step!

Here are some practical ways to hold onto hope:

- **Visualize Your Goals.** Post your Faith, Finance, and Fitness goals somewhere and read them regularly to remind you of what you're working towards.
- **Share Your Journey.** Build a community of people that share your faith and encourages you through challenges. You can lean on their strength when yours fades.
- **Embrace Change.** Remember our talk about making Halftime Adjustments? Growth often comes through discomfort. Be adaptable. Flexibility is key when pursuing God's plan.
- **Celebrate Small Wins.** Take the time to recognize and celebrate small steps. Even minor victories are a testament to your ultimate destination: Success.
