## ABOUT US

EPH partners with **21 local churches** to deliver three essential programs for families in Brown County: Transitional Housing, Long-Term Supportive Housing, and Eviction Prevention. Through a scattered-site housing model, we provide safe, stable homes for up to **41 families** at a time in single-family houses and duplexes throughout the Green Bay area. Each family receives personalized case management focused on family well-being, financial stability, housing security, employment, education, and home care. **We aim to reduce homelessness one family at a time.**

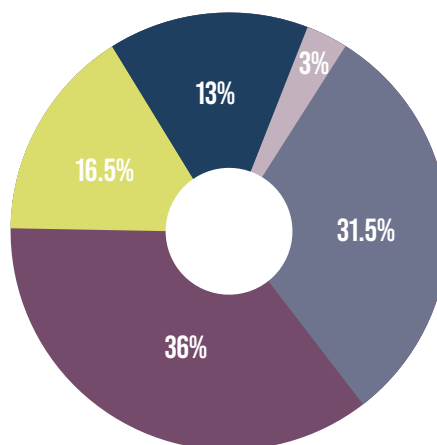
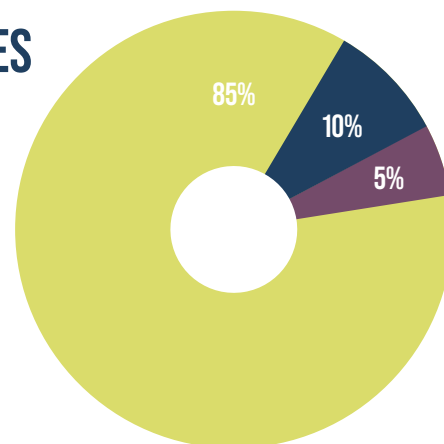
