# **INTRODUCTION**

The Annual Report was created in 1998 to provide the American Psychological Association's Commission on Accreditation (CoA) more in-depth information in between full programmatic reviews. In order to maintain accreditation from one year to the next, programs must submit detailed information in the Annual Report. In previous years, the Annual Report was submitted in paper format; however, as of 2003 all submissions were required to be completed online. Since that time, programs have submitted their information via the Annual Report Online (ARO). The ARO requires programs to submit data about their residents and supervisors, as well as information on the program as a whole. This document provides a summary of the data provided on the 2012-2013 academic year.

In the past, summary reports such as this were printed and provided annually to our constituents, professional psychology organizations, and to members of the public upon request. However, the CoA believes that these data will be better available to public electronically. Accordingly, from this point forward, all annual summary reports will be solely provided on the public website of the [Office of Program Consultation and Accreditation](#) (OPCA).

The data are provided in three main sections. First we provide data on the program as a whole. This includes items such program frequencies and annual stipends for full-time residents. The second section provides data on residents. You can find demographic information and professional activities information here. The last section summarizes data on supervisors. This is where demographic and professional activities can be found.

To better understand the data, we encourage you, as the reader and consumer, to use the information provided for your own analyses. We hope that this will facilitate better understanding of the changes occurring in our field now and in the future. Question #	Column Label	Question Wording
1	Presentations	Enter the number of workshops, oral presentations, and/or poster presentations at professional meetings the resident has been an author or co-author of. This only includes work presented during the current reporting period.
2	Articles	Enter the number of books, book chapters or articles in peer-reviewed professional or scientific journals the resident has been an author or co-author of. This only covers works published during the current reporting period. Publications "in press", "under review", or "submitted" should not be counted here.
3	Member	Indicate if the resident is a member of a professional or research society.
4	Leadership	Indicate if the resident is involved in leadership roles or activities in professional organizations. These can include roles in state/provincial, regional, or national professional organizations.

4	Research	Indicate if the supervisor was the Principal Investigator or Co-Principal Investigator on research grants or contracts during the current reporting period.
5	Services	Indicate if the supervisor is engaged in the delivery of professional services.
6	Leadership	Indicate if the supervisor was involved in leadership roles or activities in professional organizations during the current internship year. These can include roles in state/provincial, regional, or national professional organizations.
