



NOTICE OF ACTIONS – Special Review of Teach-Out Proposal
American Psychological Association - Commission on Accreditation
Summer 2023

At its meeting held August 1, 2023, the American Psychological Association’s Commission on Accreditation reviewed a proposal to teach-out students from the APA-accredited Clinical PsyD program at Medaille University. Medaille University has established a closure date of August 31, 2023. The Commission approved a teach-out proposal from D’Youville University, an institution that has not previously had an APA-accredited program. The teach-out program has been granted “accredited, on contingency (inactive)” status, effective September 1, 2023, which will allow students from the Medaille University’s APA-accredited Clinical PsyD program to enroll with a goal of continuing their studies. Should this “accredited, inactive” teach-out program wish to accept new, non-Medaille University students into a program created as a function of the teach-out, the program will not be accredited until a separate application and review and approval for initial accreditation occurs.
