

2 John 2

- (7) For many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ *as* coming in the flesh. This is the deceiver and the antichrist.
- (8) Watch yourselves, that you do not lose what we have accomplished, but that you may receive a full reward.
- (9) Anyone who goes too far and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God; the one who abides in the teaching, he has both the Father and the Son.

Matthew 7:13 and 14

(13) Enter through the narrow gate; for the gate is wide and the way is broad that leads to destruction, and there are many who enter through it.

(14) For the gate is small and the way is narrow that leads to life, and there are few who find it.

Psalm 119

(89) Forever, O LORD, Your word is settled in heaven.



Psalm 132

(2) I will bow down toward Your holy temple And give thanks to Your name for Your lovingkindness and Your truth; For You have magnified (made great) Your word according to all Your name.



(9) Anyone who goes too far and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God; the one who abides in the teaching, he has both the Father and the Son.

2 Peter 2

- (1) But false prophets also arose among the people, just as there will also be false teachers among you, who will secretly (stealthily) introduce destructive heresies (opinions), even denying the Master who bought them, bringing swift destruction upon themselves.
- (2) Many (Christians) will follow (out from the interior of their being) their sensuality (absent of restraint or rule), and because of them the way of the truth will be maligned;

2 Timothy 4

- (1) I solemnly charge *you* in the presence of God and of Christ Jesus, who is to judge the living and the dead, and by His appearing and His kingdom:
- (2) preach the word; be ready in season *and* out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort, with great patience and instruction.
- (3) For the time will come when they (God's people) will not endure (to hold or sustain an equal mind with) sound (healthy) doctrine(teaching); but wanting to have their ears tickled, they will accumulate for themselves teachers in accordance to their own desires,

2 Timothy 4

(4) and will turn away their ears from the truth and will turn aside to myths.

(5) But you, be sober in all things, endure hardship, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry.

2 Peter 2

- (2) Many will follow their sensuality (absence of restraint or standards), and because of them the way of the truth will be maligned;
- (13) suffering wrong as the wages of doing wrong. They (false teachers and prophets) count (they lead it out in the forefront of their minds) it a pleasure (sole motivation is self pleasure and self comfort; self preservation) to revel (to live delicately; softness, weak; a breaking down of the mind and making effeminate) in the daytime. They are stains and blemishes, reveling in their deceptions, as they carouse with you,
