There are a few changes that will occur with the forms/application process this year. All forms and grades will have to be uploaded to your National file online prior to the first rodeo. Remember all forms must be signed by both parents and contestants as well as notarized prior to being uploaded. If one parent has sole custody or is deceased you must write that on the forms. Waiver of liability must be completed before every rodeo and uploaded. If these forms are not completed and uploaded, you will not be able to compete. I will include a check list of forms that need to be uploaded below. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to reach out to me.
