Our Good Shepherd

Psalm 23

- 1 The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want.
- 2 He makes me lie down in green pastures; he leads me beside still waters;
- 3 he restores my soul. He leads me in right paths for his name's sake.
- 4 Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I fear no evil, for you are with me; your rod and your staff, they comfort me.
- 5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; you anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.
- 6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord my whole life long.

QUESTIONS TO CONSIDER

1. Psalm 23 describes a shepherd who serves as a provider, protector, healer, and host. How have you experienced Jesus in these ways?
2. Jesus identifies himself as the Good Shepherd who lays down his life for the sheep. How does this deepen your understanding of God's love and commitment to you?
3. As you reflect on this sermon, what is one specific way you sense God inviting you to more fully follow the Good Shepherd this week?



TIME OF RESPONSE
