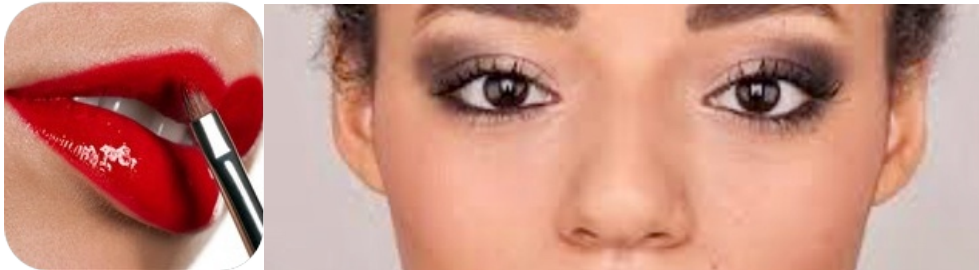


Hair and Make Up for Recital, Dress Rehearsal and Picture Week

| <p>Tips: Many dancers choose to use "Hot buns" to aid in creating a bun. Sometimes, the length of a dancer's hair deems it necessary to purchase "fake" buns.</p> | | |
| Hair for Male Dancers | | |
| <p>Males with shorter than chin length hair may leave as is. Males with longer hair should pull hair neatly back into a low ponytail and secure with an elastic to match the hair color.</p> | | |

| Make Up for female Dancers |
|--|
| Foundation/Bronzer -color that blends with face but gives a slight tan color. |
| Blush - basic rose/ pink |
| Eye Shadow - brown, tan and natural cream with a dark brown color blended (NO BLUE, PLEASE) |
| Eyeliner, Fake Eyelashes and/or Black Mascara thickly applied |
| Lipstick - bright red (not orangey or burgundy but a primary red color) |
| <p>Tips: Stage and Photography lightening sometimes washes our dancer's features out - therefore, we ask them to wear tinted foundation- bronzer, blush, eye makeup and lipstick. It is meant to accentuate their natural beauty in a complimentary way. If you are not comfortable with this, please let us know.</p> |
