

## ***A Message from Chris Harris, St. Clare School Principal . . .***



On March 6, 2023, St. Clare first grader, Walter Dixon, passed away after a battle with a rare and terminal brain tumor. During that difficult time, our school community lovingly came together to support the Dixon/French family.

His parents, Megan and David, are St. Clare parishioners and current St. Clare parents. Walter's sister Maisie is a current first grader, and his brother Augie will be joining our kindergarten in the fall. Megan and David are active in our school community, with David serving as co-chair of our PTC parent organization, and Megan a frequent volunteer in the classroom and at events.

February 11 is Walter Dixon's birthday and St. Clare School is honoring his legacy with an endowment fund dedicated to providing financial support for special programs at St. Clare School, as well as families experiencing emergency medical or financial hardship. The fund provides long-term financial assistance to ensure that all students and their families are supported. In growing this endowment, Walter's family hopes to build a lasting resource for the school's most pressing needs.

We are pleased to announce that this fund has already exceeded \$82,000, and we received the first distribution in Walter's name earlier this year as part of our annual endowment draw. This fund has raised over \$32,000 in the past year alone, thanks to donations from friends and family, the St. Clare community, and a generous match from Nike.

In September of 2024, St. Clare partnered with LEGOLAND, California to honor Walter's memory by installing a bench outside the first-grade classroom. Walter loved Legos, and LEGOLAND was honored to be asked to design a one-of-a-kind bench, complete with a Lego mosaic of Walter's artwork and signature. They also donated a special dragon LEGO set, which affectionately watches over students that come to visit the principal office.

Earlier this week on February 11th, St. Clare celebrated Walter on his heavenly birthday. His parents, St. Clare parishioners Megan French and David Dixon, partnered with local bakery Baker and Spice who generously donated cookies for all of our students in celebration of Walter. Many in our community were able to share a special memory and recall Walter with fondness on his special day.



***“This and That “from Deacon Bill . . .***

The Feast of the Epiphany, January 6, 2025, Pope Leo closed the Holy Doors of the Vatican marking the end of the Pilgrims of Hope Jubilee Year. Many pilgrims journeyed to Rome, including a large group from our own parish, to celebrate this special time which Pope Francis had proclaimed in 2024.

So, what’s next? It didn’t take long. 2026 marks 800 years since the death of St. Francis of Assisi.


On January 10, the Apostolic Penitentiary, a Vatican tribunal who deals with matters of the conscience, issued a decree published by the Franciscan Friars declaring a yearlong celebration in honor of the *Poverello*, or Little Poor One. According to this decree, Pope Leo has established, a special Year of St. Francis of Assisi until January 10, 2027, that may be proclaimed in every diocese, in which every Christian, “following the example of St. Francis, may himself become a model of holiness of life and constant witness of peace.” Noting previous celebrations related to the works of St. Francis such as the eighth centenary commemoration of the first Nativity scene, as well as the composition of the “Canticle of the Creatures” and his receiving the stigmata – the declaration stated that “2026 will mark the culminations and fulfillment of previous celebrations.”

In its proclamation, the Apostolic Penitentiary also announced that plenary indulgences will be granted to Catholics “under usual conditions (sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father) which can also be applied in the form of suffrage for the souls in Purgatory.” The indulgence will be granted to those who participate in a pilgrimage “to any Franciscan conventual church, or place of worship in any part of the world named after him.” For all of us here at St. Clare, we would need to visit St. Francis Church in Sherwood.

Since this being a special year honoring St. Francis and the many saints that followed in his footsteps, I hope to focus on our saints that surround us. Fr. Don informed us that the first Mass was celebrated on Christmas Eve in 1950. At that time, we were a parish overseen by Franciscans. They, along with some parishioners, were responsible for the religious symbols in the architecture, Stations of the Cross, stained-glass windows, etc. in our church.

*St. Clare Windows*, a beautiful book published in 2012 was written by Sheila Cullen, a wonderful parishioner, volunteer and go to person for almost 47 years. Parts of the book and pictures of the windows appeared in the parish bulletin in 2013. I like many of our newer generation of members may be wondering who are these saints depicted on our windows letting their light and grace shine on us and joining with us as we worship together?




