Confirmation is a pivotal moment in our students' faith journeys. At age 12/13, they are beginning to shape their understanding of the world and their beliefs. Although, some may feel their child is too young or not ready to make this commitment, this process is designed to support their growth and encourage a deeper connection to their faith at a formative age.

I believe that engaging with faith at this stage can be both enlightening and enriching. It's an opportunity for students to ask questions, explore their spirituality, and grow in their understanding of the Catholic tradition.

Our goal is to create a supportive environment where students can explore their beliefs and build a personal relationship with God. In our classes, we will:

- **Explore Faith:** Connect Catholic beliefs with their daily lives.
- **Build a Personal Relationship with God:** Show how faith brings strength and joy.
- **Relate Faith to Daily Life:** Apply Church teachings to real-life challenges.
- **Encourage Reflection:** Provide space for questions and personal insights.
- **Live Out Our Faith Through Service:** Participate in monthly service projects during class to help students experience the joy of giving back and understand the importance of community.

**Classes will be on the First and Third Sunday of each month from January through May from 12pm-2pm.** During this time we will do a service project together, and have engaging teaching.

**Regular attendance at both classes and weekend Mass is required.** This consistency not only supports your youth's understanding but also deepens their relationship with God and the Church community.

I'm dedicated to making this experience meaningful. By the end, I hope each student will have a deeper understanding of their faith and feel more connected to God and their community.
