## Early Giving starts November 17th!

This year, St. Mary's Nativity School is focusing our iGiveCatholic campaign on creating a centralized outdoor **Courtyard of Fellowship**—a dedicated area on campus where students, families, and parish community members can gather, learn, and grow together. Our campus currently lacks a single, structured space that naturally brings people together, and this project directly addresses that need.

The courtyard will be located in the heart of our school grounds and will serve as a visible, welcoming hub for our entire community. Our first phase is to install a **finished cement foundation**, which will provide a safe, durable, and accessible surface for gatherings and outdoor learning. Thanks to the generosity of the St. Joseph Dinner Impact Table, we have already secured five powder-coated steel picnic tables, which will anchor this space and make it immediately usable once the foundation is poured.


